

### Harold Bruce Macmillan O.B.E., F.R.P.S.L. 1907 – 1984

For some 50 years Mr. Macmillan worked for the well-known Printing Company, R. B. Macmillan Ltd. He retired as Chairman in 1982 when he was made Honorary President of the Company. He had served on many local and national printing committees. During the last war he served with distinction in the Western Desert.

He was a generous supporter of many Charities and was strongly committed to the cause of Cancer Relief (which was founded by his uncle, Douglas Macmillan). At the time of his death Mr. Macmillan was Senior Trustee of the Society and recently he had played a very active part in establishing the Nightingale Macmillan Home for Cancer Sufferers in Derby.

Mr. Macmillan loved his stamps. His interests were wide indeed and although he always considered himself to be a "stamp collector" he possessed deep philatelic knowledge. He was a keen member of the West African Study Circle and a Fellow of the Society of Postal Historians. He was always happy to share his knowledge with other collectors and his displays to Societies were invariably accompanied by talks which were models of lucidity.

The auctioneers exercise all reasonable care to ensure that all statements as to cancellation, centring, colour, condition, date of issue or of postal marking, gum, margins, paper, perforation, printing, provencance, quality, sheet position, status, usage, watermark, etc. In lot descriptions are reliable and accurate, and that each item is genuine unless the contrary is indicated. However, the statements are not intended to be, are not and are not to be taken to be, statements of fact or representations of fact in relation to the lot. They are statements of the opinion of the auctioneers, and attention is particularly drawn to clause 5 of the PHILATELIC AUCTIONEERS' STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE (1973 REVISION) set out below. Comments and opinions, concerning the characteristics mentioned above. which may be found in or on lots as notes, lists, catalogue prices, writing up or any other means of expression, do not constitute part of lot description and are not to be taken as such unless they are made or specifically verified by the auctioneers.

#### Clause 1

- (a) Each lot is put up subject to any reserve price imposed by the vendor.

- (h)If any purchaser fails to pay in full for any lot within the time stated in sub-clause (a) of this clause such lot may at any time thereafter at the auctioneer's discretion to put up for sale by auction again or sold privately; if upon such re-sale a lower price is obtained than was obtained on the first sale the purchaser in default on the first sale shall make good the difference in price and the expenses of resale which shall become a debt due from him.






