

- 2) Enter on the Postal Bidding Form the maximum amount you are prepared to pay for all of the lots in which you are interested. You may limit your total expenditure (excluding post and packing) by marking the box provided.
- 3) The Auctioneer will bid on your behalf free of charge and buy at the lowest possible price subject only to other bids received or reserves, i.e. at one bidding step above the second highest bid. Where a single bid higher than the estimated price is received, the lot will be sold at estimate however high the bid.
- 4) Telephone bids may be made (0423 865962) but must be confirmed in writing.
- 5) No Lot will be sold for less than 75% of estimate.
- 6) Bidding increases are as follows:

- 8) In all other cases, a "Pro Forma Invoice" will be sent. Payment should be made within 7 days of receipt.
