RARITY OF THE STRIKE

A notation as to the scarcity of a strike will follow the listing and is an indication of Foster's estimates of the quantity of the strikes available per page 63 of his handbook.

VR – Indicates very rare plus the number indicates the quantity known.

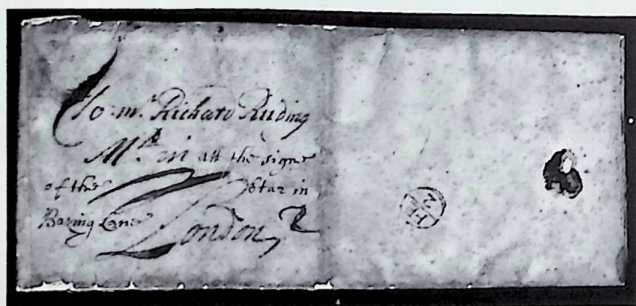

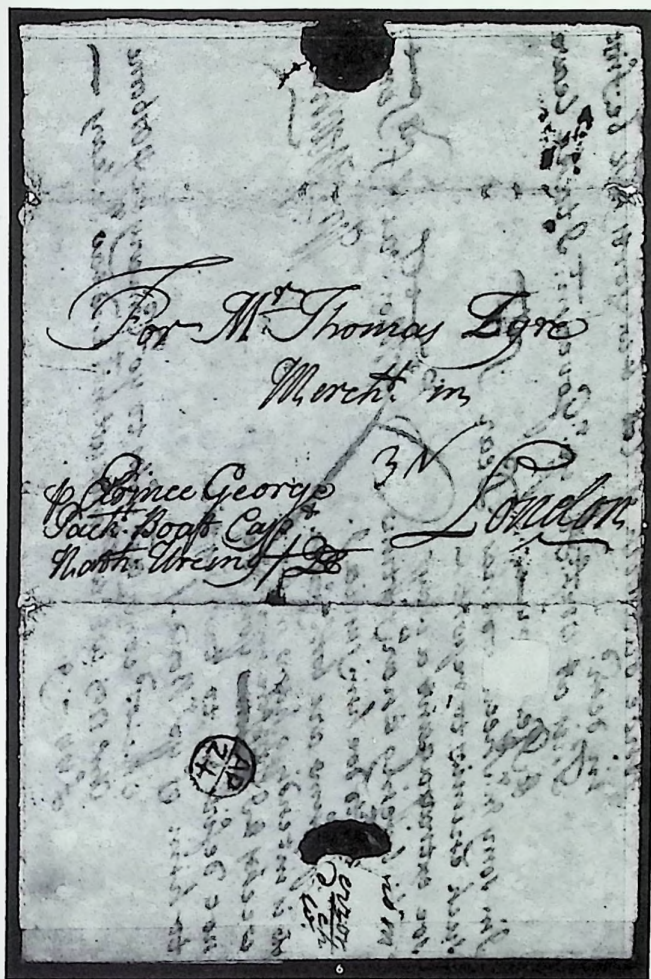
