## FOREWORD

Leslie S. Wheeler, F.R.P.S.L., began collecting stamps at around the age of ten and has continued ever since.


He qualified as a chartered accountant in 1933 and was engaged for twelve years in that profession, spending the war years on work of national importance in connection with food supplies. After the war he became prominent in dairy trade circles and held various executive and honorary posts in dairying. In addition to his qualifications as an accountant, he is a Fellow and President of the Institute of Arbitrators, also a Freeman of the City of London and a Liveryman of the Worshipful Company of Horners. He is immensely interested in hospital work and is Chairman of the Governors of the New Victoria Hospital, Kingston, Surrey.



He started to collect Barbados stamps seriously just after World War II, and in 1963 he displayed his collection to the Royal Philatelic Society, of which he is a Fellow, Council Member and now, Honorary Treasurer. He won a Silver-gilt medal at Vienna in 1965, a Gold-silver medal at Washington in 1966 and a Gold medal at "Amphilex" in 1967. His Barbados collection stops at 1960, when in fact, he stopped buying new issues. He has special interest in Malta and Newfoundland.
