P R E F A C E .

In presenting this, my first attempt at a complete catalogue of U. S. Stamps, I would state that I am a collector of *United States Stamps Only*, in all their varieties, colors, dies, etc., of both Postage and Revenue.

I have aimed at a complete list, but not having seen all that I quote, presume they exist, from the majority of specimens in my collection, and possessing, as I do, nearly two-thirds of all quoted. The dies, colors of paper, and varieties are given in full of the Plimpton series of Envelopes and the War Department Envelopes; also. the Unperforate and Part-perforate Document, cut and uncut Medicine, etc., including every stamp issued to January, 1877.

It is presented to my friends more for a guide list to ascertain the value of stamps in their collections, than a price list, yet it combines both; being a novelty in itself and original with the compiler. It is the first catalogue of its kind ever attempted by a collector or dealer, and I trust my Philatelic friends will receive it in the same generous spirit in which it is given to the public.

It is my aim to publish a complete list, which I shall try to do, if this, my first effort, meets with approbation, and would respectfully ask of critics to correct such errors as appear in this edition, with a view to perfection in my next attempt, which will embrace Tobacco, Cigar, Snuff, Beer, License, California and Nevada Stamps, etc.

SPECIAL NOTICES.

In ordering from this Catalogue, collectors will please observe the following instructions:

Every stamp sold is warranted genuine, and a written guarantee to that effect will be given whenever desired.

All orders should be plainly written out and stating whether the specimens wanted are for the used or unused, giving the date, color, and value of each stamp, with the sender's name and post office address each time.

In sending money through the mail, have the amount in as few pieces as possible; if change is required, do not send pennies, but unused U. S. postage stamps of low values. All sums of three dollars and upwards should be sent either by Post Office Order or in Registered Letter. I cannot become responsible for money sent otherwise. All letters containing over five dollars' worth of stamps for sale or exchange, should be sent registered or prepaid by express; I will do the same in return.

To those who are starting collections I would specially recommend my packets, which have proved a decided success, and have now been thoroughly revised and improved.

I do not wish to say that I have in stock all the stamps priced in this list, as that is really impossible for any dealer, no matter how large his stock may be, but I can assure my patrons that all orders will be promptly executed. However, I have no hesitation in asserting that my stock of Revenues and low values of Envelopes is second to none in the country, and is constantly increasing.

ABBREVIATIONS.—Obl. (oblong), oct. (octagonal), hex. (hexagon), sq. (square), rect. (rectangular), triang. (triangular), refer to the shape of the stamps.

Sheets of Stamps sent on approval to responsible parties at 25 per cent. discount from Catalogue rates.

Letters of inquiry and orders under twenty-five cents must contain a stamp for return postage.

I am continually purchasing large quantities of stamps, and hope that those who have any good stamps to sell, either in collections or otherwise, will give me a chance to purchase. Those I *do not* wish to purchase, in Postage, are marked with a dagger (†), but want all others. Those I specially want in Revenues are marked with a star (*), for which I will allow in exchange from one-half to two-thirds my list prices for limited quantities in good condition. I do not charge my list prices for any torn, clipped, greasy, or badly defaced stamps. Envelope stamps are cut square, and my offer only extends to the same quality.
