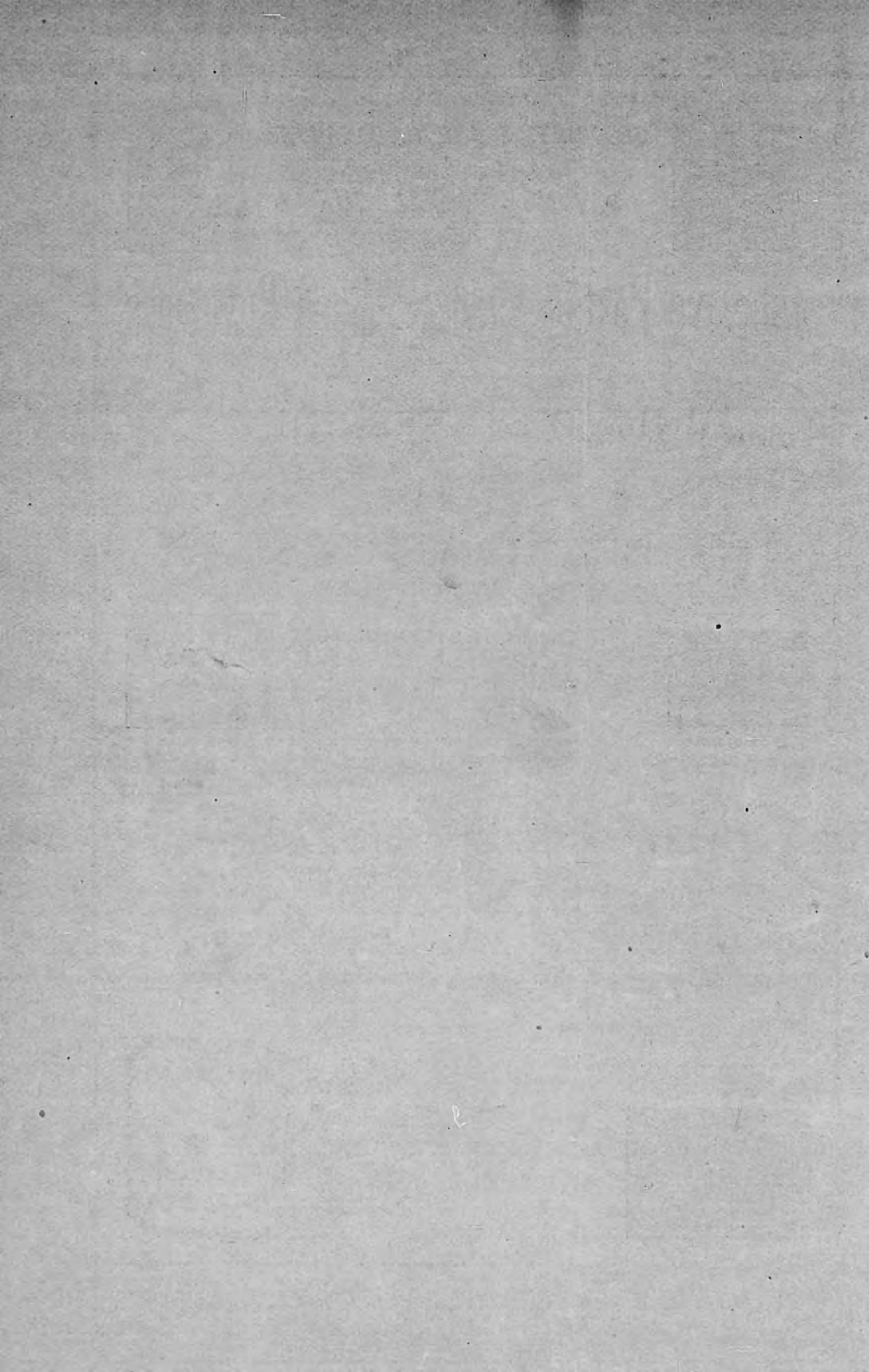

For envelopes, a frame work of 33x35 millimetres should be allowed, as the margin must be large to retain their beauty and value.

# ENVELOPE STAMPS.

## General Issue.

Those issued from 1853 to 1868, inclusive, are known as the NESBITT ISSUE.

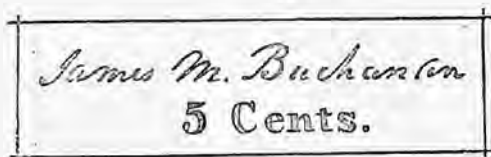

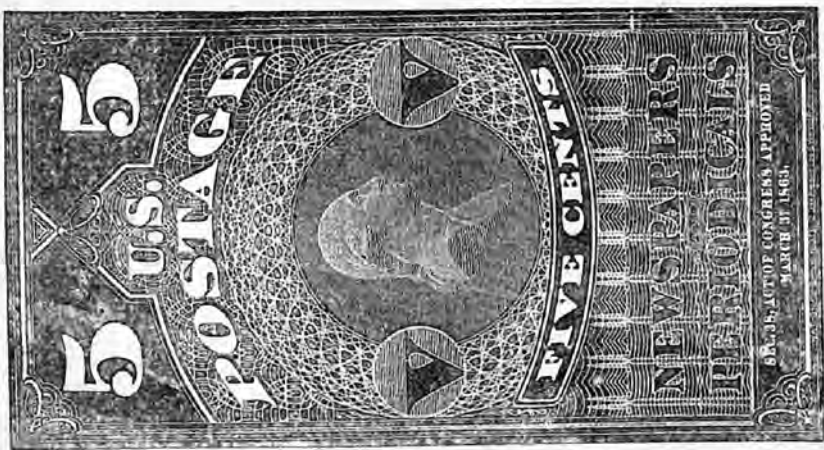

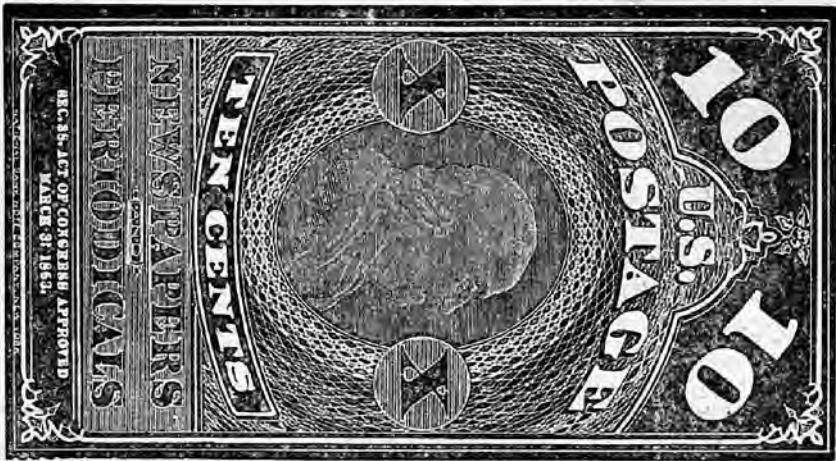
