PREFACE.

The first edition of my Catalogue was issued in 1877, and combined both Postage and Revenue Stamps of the United States only. The second edition of my Catalogue was issued in 1882, and contained both adhesive Postage and Stamped Envelopes of the United States only, illustrated with 100 cuts of rare stamps. They were both greeted by the Philatelic Press and advanced Collectors with many kind expressions of general merit, and in presenting this, my third edition, which is simply an accurate and complete list of all Postage and Envelope Stamps issued by the United States Government, (Illustrated lists are now things of the past, owing to the ruling of the Treasury Department) it has been my aim to make this a plain and comprehensive list to all, so that the youngest as well as the more advanced Collectors will be better able to detect the rare from the common, and know the value of what they possess.

I feel assured that this Catalogue will awaken a deeper interest in the Postage Stamps of our own country, which have been sadly neglected by our young collectors for those of foreign countries, as it takes the place of a long-desired want, and being the only Catalogue describing the Stamps of the United States, it must certainly rank as a standard book of reference, as great pains have been taken to make it very complete and accurate in every detail, and to this end no expense

or labor has been spared.

If anyone will compare the rapid advance in prices of United States Stamps during the past two years they will readily see how the demand for stamps of this country has steadily grown until now the actual market value of every variety offered two years ago has increased over four-fold. The demand for first-class stamps is far greater than the supply we are able to obtain of the rare varieties, and if one will only watch the buyers at an auction sale to see how eagerly the rare United States stamps are bid for they will not wonder at the rapid advance. Thousands of collectors are now beginning to see how they have neglected United States stamps for those of foreign countries, and regret at this day when the ordinary types of a few years ago which they did not care for then are now worth dollars, and many of them beyond their reach, which they could have obtained for a few cents.

The reduction in postage from three cents to two cents for first-class mail matter of one-half ounce weight that went into effect October 1, 1883, has given the lovers of Stamped Envelopes plenty of active work to keep posted in regard to the numerous changes to which I have given a careful study, so the list of October and November issues will

be found accurate and reliable.

I have been greatly encouraged by the support given me by the leading Philatelists in this country in my efforts to establish a trade solely in the stamps of the United States, which to me has been a source of both profitable and pleasurable amusement, and I thank my correspondents, one and all, for their most generous support, and trust to merit a continuance of their patronage in the future.

The average sizes of Adhesive Stamps, unless otherwise stated, is 20x25 millimetres without perforations, but when ruling spaces in albums allow a larger space for frame work. For envelopes, a frame work of 33x35 millimetres should be allowed, as the margin must be large to retain their beauty and value.



TIN FOILS were introduced in the latter part of 1868, and two denominations were issued, the half-ounce bearing the Arms of the United States printed in blue on bright surface foil, and the one-ounce Head of Washington, printed in gold on bright surfaced foil. The half-ounce was not long in use, having been abolished by law, June 16, 1872. Five things are to be noticed in describing the foils:

1. The issue, which is indicated by the Stamps, whose position is usually on the

lower half of the foil.

2. The manufacturing proprietorship, which is indicated in the circle of cancel-2. The maintacturing profite control of the Stamp's margin.

3. The brand, which is printed either in a frame or ornamental lettering, and has its position usually above the stamp.

4. The color, which atways takes its name from the color of the STAMP, even when the Brand is indicated by a different color.

5. The kind of foil, whether Bright, silver or Ribbed Silver.

#### GRAPHIC CO.'S TOBACCO WRAPPERS AND STAMPS,

Which in 1878 and 1879 were prepared for such Tobacco manufacturers as chose to avail themselves of this means of embodying a Trade Mark and Internal Revenue

Stamp in the form authorized by Government.

Three types were authorized, and live denominations (1, 2, 4, 8 and 16* ounces.)

The use of the wrappers was not general, and was of brief duration. The types are described as follows:

Type A. Profile head of Liberty in garter, 1 and 2 ounces. Type B. Head of Liberty in small circle, 2 and 4 ounces. Type C. Profile of Franklin, 8 and 16 ounces.

^{*}It is not known that the 16-ounce denomination was ever actually used, but it was prepared, and proof specimens are in existence.




