PREFACE.

THE first edition of my Catalogue was issued in 1877, and combined both Postage and Revenue Stamps of the United States only. The second edition of my Catalogue was issued in 1882, and contained both adhesive Postage and Stamped Envelopes of the United States only, illustrated with 100 cuts of rare stamps. The third edition of my Catalogue was issued in 1884, and described 551 varieties of adhesive Postage and Stamped Envelopes. The demand far exceeded my expectations. They were all greeted by the Philatelic Press and advanced Collectors with many kind expressions of general merit, and in presenting this, my fourth edition, which covers more ground and describes more fully all Postage and Envelope Stamps issued by the United States Government. The Telegraph Stamps issued by various corporations, Postal Currency, Metallic Currency and Postal Notes, all of which are worthy of being collected. It has been my aim to make this a plain and comprehensive list to all, so that the youngest as well as the more advanced Collectors will be better able to detect the rare from the common and know the value of what they possess.

Some of the great *rarities* I have not priced from the fact that they are not to be had, and they are cheap at any price when offered for sale.

If anyone will compare the rapid advance in prices of United States stamps during the past two years, they will readily see how the demand for stamps of this country has steadily grown until now the actual market value of every variety offered two years ago has increased over four-fold. The demand for first-class stamps is far greater than the supply we are able to obtain of the rare varieties, and if one will only watch the buyers at an auction sale to see how eagerly the rare United States stamps are bid for they will not wonder at the rapid advance. Thousands of collectors are now beginning to see how they have neglected United States stamps for those of foreign countries, and regret at this day when the ordinary types of a few years ago which they did not care for then are now worth dollars, and many of them beyond their reach, which they could have obtained for a few cents.

It is impossible for me to answer all letters on receipt, but will attend to the same at very earliest possible moment, and so state this from the fact that my banking business will not permit me to devote time to my hobby during banking hours, and all stamp work is carried on in the evenings at my residence. I thank my correspondents, one and all, for their most generous support during the past, and trust to merit a continuance of their patronage in the future.

S. Stamps; yet it is impossible to have on hand at times all rare stamps mentioned, and it would be well to send an additional list of wants to select from when ordering from this Catalogue.

I have also issued a Descriptive Catalogue (fourth edition) of the Revenue Stamps of the United States, describing with price over 1,600 varieties, which will be sent post-paid to any address on receipt of twenty-five cents.

I want all kinds of U. S. old issues, Adhesive Postage and Envelopes of every description, in good condition only, for which the best cash or exchange prices will be given.

The average sizes of Adhesive Stamps, unless otherwise stated, is 20x25 millimetres without perforations, but when ruling spaces in albums allow a larger space for frame work. For envelopes, a frame work of 33x35 millimetres should be allowed, as the margin must be large to retain their beauty and value.
