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PREFACE.

THE first edition of my Catalogue was issued in 1877, and combined both Postage and Revenue Stamps of the United States only. The second edition of my Catalogue was issued in 1882, and contained both adhesive Postage and Stamped Envelopes of the United States only, illustrated with 100 cuts of rare Stamps. The third edition of my Catalogue was issued in 1884, and described 551 varieties of adhesive Postage and Stamped Envelopes. The fourth edition was issued January, 1886, and was disposed of in two months, so that the fifth edition is simply a necessity. The demand for the fourth edition far exceeded my expectation, of which I can justly feel proud as it shows the immense demand for a standard work of the value of U. S. issues and the rapid increase in collectors of U. S. Stamps. The Telegraph Stamps issued by various corporations, Postal Currency, Metallic Currency and Postal Notes, all of which are worthy of being collected, are included; and the descriptive list of the issues of the Southern Confederacy is very complete and accurate, for which I am indebted to my friend Mr. Joseph Rechert, as it contains many stamps never before listed. It has been my aim to make this a plain and comprehensive list to all, so that the youngest as well as the more advanced Collectors will be better able to detect the rare from the common and know the value of what they possess.

Some of the great *rarities* I have not priced from the fact that they are not to be had, and they are cheap at any price when offered for sale.

If anyone will compare the rapid advance in prices of United States stamps during the past two years, they will readily see how the demand for Stamps in this country has steadily grown until now the actual market value of every variety offered two years ago has increased over four-fold. The demand for first-class stamps is far greater than the supply we are able to obtain of the rare varieties, and if one will only watch the buyers at an auction sale to see how eagerly the rare United States Stamps are bid for they will not wonder at the rapid advance. Thousands of collectors are now beginning to see how they have neglected United States Stamps for those of foreign countries, and regret at this day when the ordinary types of a few years ago which they did not care for then are now worth dollars, and many of them beyond their reach, which they could have obtained for a few cents.

It is impossible for me to answer all letters on receipt, but will attend to the same at very earliest possible moment, and so state this from the fact that my banking business will not permit me to devote time to my hobby during banking hours, and all Stamp work is carried on in the evenings at my residence. I thank my correspondents, one and all, for their most generous support during the past, and trust to merit a continuance of their patronage in the future.

I handle United States Stamps of all kinds, both Postage and Revenue, having made this branch of Philately a study for the past *twelve years*, so that collectors will find a very large stock to order from, having over \$10,000 invested in all branches of U. S. Stamps ; yet is impossible to have on hand at times all rare Stamps mentioned, and it would be well to send an additional list of wants to select from when ordering from this Catalogue.

I have also issued a descriptive Catalogue (fourth edition) of the Revenue Stamps of the United States, describing with price over 1,600 varieties, which will be sent post-paid to any address on receipt of twenty-five cents.

Valuable collections of United States Stamps taken on sale at twenty-five per cent. commission.

I attend in person all auction sales of stamps in New York City, and solicit the bids of my correspondents who cannot attend, at ten per cent. commission.

I want all kinds of U. S. old issues, Adhesive Postage and Envelopes of every description, in good condition only, for which the best cash or exchange prices will be given.

The average sizes of Adhesive Stamps, unless otherwise stated, is 20x25 millimetres without perforations, but when ruling spaces in albums allow a larger space for frame work. For envelopes, a frame work of 33x35 millimetres should be allowed, as the margin must be large to retain their beauty and value.

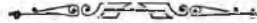

The following is a list of the Provisional Stamps that were issued in 1861 by the various postmasters of the Southern cities prior to the regular issue by the Confederate Government. They were all recognized by the Government of the Confederate States, and letters franked with these stamps were delivered free of postage within the limits of the Confederacy.

All these stamps are scarce and some very rare, as they were in use but a short time, and were suppressed as soon as the stamps issued by the Confederate Government were received. The following are actually known to exist, and I am indebted to my friend Mr. Joseph Rechart for assistance in compiling the list, and feel assured it will be of great benefit to collectors in general:

S. envelopes were seized by the Confederate Government, and the stamp having no value these surcharges made these envelopes an official issue for transmitting "free public matter" through the mail. Mr. Rechert succeeded in finding the Chief Clerk of the Contract Bureau in New York, whose identification of the above envelopes leaves no doubt as to their authenticity.
