AN APOLOGY.

The Sixth Edition of my Standard Descriptive Postage Stamp Catalogue, advertised to be ready January 1st, 1887, has been greatly delayed, and I regret very much that such has been the case. I can assure those, however, who have sent their money and have patiently waited for the appearance of the Catalogue, that they will be fully repaid for the delay, from the fact that the Catalogue contains far more than any edition ever sent out by me, or any list ever published upon the subject of United States Postage and Local Stamps.

It contains full descriptions of all varieties of recent discoveries in old issues, complete list of the Government Reprints in adhesives, while the list of the U. S. Local Postage is a volume in itself. The dies and varieties of envelopes are fully explained. All the stamps are numbered, and the numbers changed from the old catalogues, so that past editions will not correspond with the numbers in this edition.

I have given much time and attention to the work, and trust it will be fully appreciated, as have all my former editions.

The average sizes of adhesive stamps, unless otherwise stated, is 20x25 millimetres without perforations, but when ruling spaces in albums allow a larger space for framework. For envelopes, a framework of 33x35 millimetres should be allowed, as the margin must be large to retain their beauty and value.

I have ordered 100 extra copies to be printed on heavy toned paper, interleaved, and bound in a very handsome manner, the price of which will be \$1.00, delivered to any address. Orders for the same will be received and sent when finished.

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PREFACE.

THE first edition of my Catalogue was issued in 1877, and combined both Postage and Revenue Stamps of the United States. The second edition of my Catalogue was issued in 1882, and contained both Adhesive Postage and Stamped Envelopes of the United States, illustrated with 100 cuts of rare stamps. The third edition of my Catalogue was issued in 1884, and described 551 varieties of Adhesive Postage and Stamped Envelopes. The fourth edition was issued January, 1886, and was disposed of in two months, so that the fifth edition was simply a necessity. The demand for the fourth and fifth editions far exceeded my expectation, of which I am justly proud, as it shows the immense demand for a standard work of the value of U. S. issues and the rapid increase in collectors of U. S. Stamps. The sixth edition I have deferred until January 1, 1887, in order to cover all of the new issues in Envelopes for 1886, which made their appearance October 1, but in very limited numbers, owing to the large supply on hand at the different post offices at the old contract price; hence Post Offices were not supplied with the new Envelopes as long as the old stock was unsold. The Telegraph Stamps issued by various corporations, Postal Currency, Metallic Currency and Postal Notes, all of which are collected, are included; and the descriptive list of the issues of the Southern Confederacy is very complete and accurate and corrected to date, for which I am indebted to my friend Mr. Joseph Rechert, president of the New York Philatelic Society. The complete list of the Local Stamps issued by the old Express Companies and others is a great addition to the present issue of the Catalogue, as it adds a feature long expressed by collectors of these interesting and rare stamps, and should be greatly appreciated by those for whom this extra part of my Catalogue will be of benefit. For this fine and accurate list I am indebted to my friend Dr. W. H. Mitchell, who fully understands his subject. The issues for the 1c. and 3c. stamps of 1851-57 would form a volume by themselves, and I would advise the active study of this issue of Postage, for the student will find many rarities that I have not listed and which will be most fully described through the active research of that advanced and thorough collector, Mr. John K. Tiffany, in his work on the issues of the Postage Stamps of the United States, soon to appear. I am also indebted to my friend Mr. E. B. Hanes for kind and valuable suggestions.

My advice to stamp collectors is, Study your Stamps, as the old issues are far from perfect. The plates and dies were not as accurate as

at the present day, and many varieties of the 1847-1857 issues are yet to be found.

I cannot answer all letters on receipt, and so state this from the fact that my banking business will not permit me to devote time to my hobby during banking hours, as all Stamp work is carried on in the evenings at my residence, so that my correspondents will bear with me, and I will reply to all at the earliest possible moment that my limited time will permit.

23. DIE 3.—5 dots; center one square; large E in office and top touches the circle; the outer dots appear uniform and from the points. No point after cents.

24. DIE 4.—5 very distinct dots; centre one oblong; single point in left lower scroll work, pointing to the ball; S in post very distinct and round; S in cents very much blurred and looks like figure 8. No point after cents.

25. DIE 5.—5 dots and at uniform distance apart; centre one rectangular; the balls at the side touch the circle; P in post and E in office rest almost upon the P and I. No point after cents.

26. DIE 6.—4 dots above circle; E in office nearly touches the I of R. I.; very broad top to S in cents. Point after cents.

They were all recognized by the Government of the Confederate States, and letters franked with these stamps were delivered free of postage within the limits of the Confederacy.

All these stamps are scarce and some very rare, as they were in use but a short time, and were suppressed as soon as the stamps issued by the Confederate Government were received. The following are actually known to exist, and I am indebted to my friend Mr. Joseph Reehert for assistance in compiling the list, and feel assured it will be of great benefit to collectors in general.

ODDITIES IN ENTIRE U. S. ENVELOPES.

In order to facilitate the description of these envelopes I have though best to describe them under ten different classes or varieties, viz.:

Variety 1.—Showing how Albinos are made: two or more envelopes folded together, the outer one receiving the impression in color, the inner one the impression without color; doubles. Extremely rare.

Variety 2.—Showing the correct color of impression of stamp on inside of envelope, the outer impression without color. These have all received two impressions. Very rare.

Variety 3.—Partial Albinos; that is, where the stamp has received the correct color in part, and the balance of stamp a plain Albino. Very rare.

Variety 4.—Two impressions of stamps, one on obverse, the other on reverse, of envelope, with or without color. Very rare.

Variety 5.—Stamp impressed in color on reverse of envelope; one and two stamps. Very rare.

Variety 6.—Two or more stamps impressed in correct colors on obverse, linked together in various positions. Very odd and rare.

Variety 7.—Albinos. The stamp impressed on envelope without color, in normal position. Rare.

Variety 8.—Stamp in correct color, but in various odd positions on the envelope.

Variety 9.—Mistrikes, showing two impressions: the one in color, the other slightly projecting beyond the normal stamp without color.

Variety 10.—Miscellaneous. Consisting of odds in flaps, watermarks, gum, &c.

REFERENCE LIST OF LOCALS.

The Local Stamps of the United States have been for the past few years regarded with indifference by many, and no catalogue to date has given the information that is desired in a "List."

The compiler is indebted to Mr. Coster's work for much information, supplemented by correspondence with various specialists who "love locals for their own worth."

Most catalogues arrange these stamps without regard to the issues, and in many instances the stamps of the same post are catalogued as if issued by different parties.

In such cases as were possible, the history of the post shows that one proprietor sold out or was absorbed by another. In these we have arranged them so as to show such change of proprietorship. The chronology, so far as possible, is denoted by the Roman numerals after the name of a post, thus, CXXI. The * shows if a used stamp is on the original letter; the † denotes that they are known to have existed at this date but may have been in use previous to the date indicated; where the date is entirely a matter of doubt, ?; the ‡ shows that the value is not indicated on the stamp. When such value is known it is inserted in parenthesis (5 cents). The check list, in order to prevent confusion, will have the cipher '0' before the numeral, as 017.

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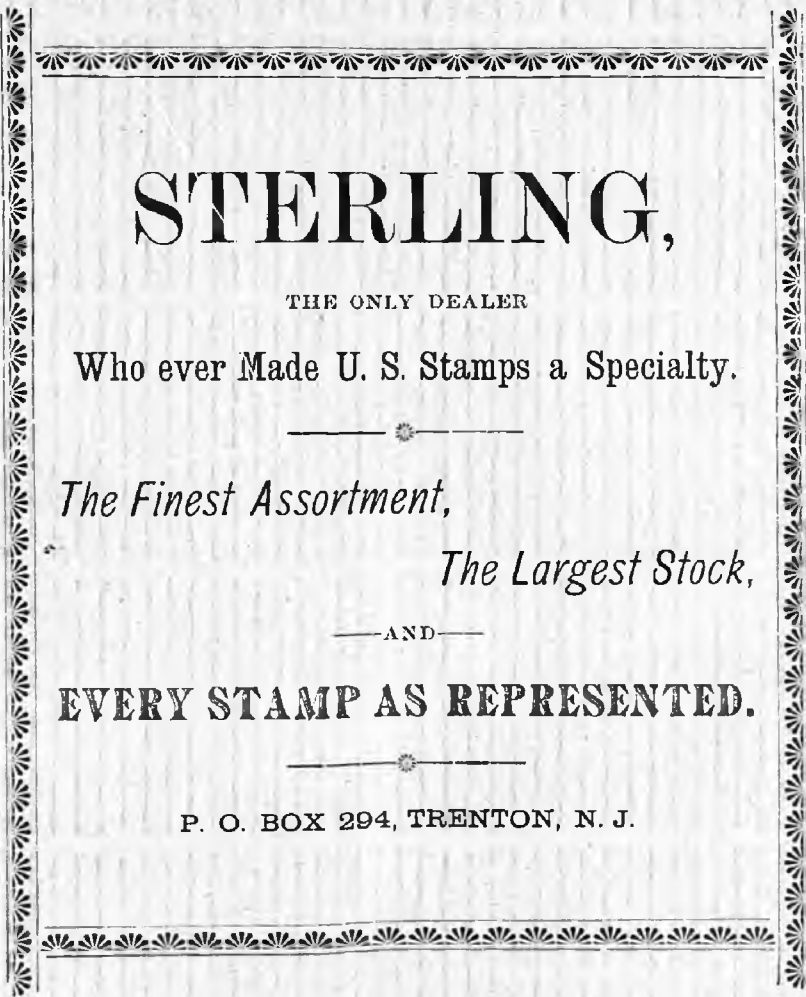
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
