TIN FOLLS were introduced in the latter part of 1868, and two denominations were blue on bright surface foil, and the one-counce Head of Washington, printed in gold on bright surfaced foil. The half-ounce was not long in use, having been abolished by law, June 6, 1872. Five things are to be noticed in describing the foils:

1st. The issue, which is indicated by the Stamps whose position is usually on the lower

half of the Foil.

2d. The manufacturing proprietorship, which is indicated in the circle of cancellation usually at the bottom of the center of the stamp's margin.

3d. The brand, which is printed either in a frame or ornamental lettering, and has its

position usually abrice the stamp. 4th. The color, which always takes its name from the color of the Stant, even when the Brand is indicated by a different color.

5th. The kind of foil, whether Bright, Silver or Ribbed Silver.

## Graphic Co. Tobacco Wrappers and Stamps,

Which in 1878 and 1879 were prepared for such Tobacco manufacturers as chose to avail them-selves of this means of embodying a Trade Mark and internal revenue stamp in the form authorized by Government.

Three types were authorized, and five denominations (1, 2, 4, 8 and 10\* ounces.) The use of the wrappers was not general, and was of brief duration. The types are described as follows:

Type A Profile head of Liberty in garter, 1 and 2 ounces. Type B Head of Liberty in small circle, 2 and 4 ounces. Type C. Profile of Franklin, 8 and 16 ounces.

<sup>\*</sup> It is not known that the 16-ounce denomination was ever actually used, but it was prepared, and proof specimens are in existence. [SEE LAST COVER.]

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## PREFACE.

IN presenting this my third edition of the Revenue Stamp Catalogue, I feel f L justified in saying that it is the most complete and best Descriptive Catalogue or List ever given to the Stamp-collecting public. It has been carefully compared with the Stamps in the largest collections of U.S. Revenues possessed in this country, and it is the work of several years' active study by the Compiler. The Stamps here presented are known to actually exist, and no stampethat I have not seen, or reported to me on the best authority, are listed. A few omissions may be found, and if so, I would be glad to have the Stamps sent me for examination, guaranteeing their safe return. The listing of Revenue Stamps on the different papers was first presented to collectors' notice by my Lists published in the Philatelic papers and journals. many of which have long since been out of existence, so that a new list, complete in every detail, is greatly in demand. No Revenue Collector would think of forming a collection without consulting these details, for the rarity of the Stamp depends upon the variety or kind of paper upon which it is printed.

The Internal Revenue tax on Proprietary Articles having been abolished by law, July 1st, 1883, the Stamps herein contained will gradually become more scarce and rare with each year, for these interesting souvenirs of the late war are being greatly sought after and the demand is on the increase, while the supply has entirely ceased. The limit having been reached, I would advise all young collectors to avail themselves of the present and secure what they lack to complete their sets before such Stamps are beyond their reach.




