PREFACE.

It is with the greatest diffidence that we offer this little work to the Revenue Stamp Collectors of the World, being fully aware of its shortcomings, but when it is considered that this is the first attempt that has been made to classify and arrange the various revenue stamps that have been found dispersed among the postage stamp albums of amateurs, we hope its errors of omission will be pardoned. Our publishers request us to state that intelligent criticism of it will be gladly received for publication in *The American Journal of Philately*; also that they will pay 25 cents for the first specimen received of any revenue stamp not catalogued

in its pages.

A few words concerning the collection of Revenue Stamps may not be out of place to those thinking of commencing their study. Among the advantages revenues possess over postage stamps, may be mentioned the following: First, Revenue stamp collecting is quite new, thus offering to those who commence immediately the same advantages reaped by postal amateurs who obtained copies of the first issues of British Guiana Sandwich Isles Reunion, etc., etc., some dozen years ago, which later comers have found it impossible to procure except at enormous cost, and we firmly believe there are many stamps quoted at 25 cents and under in this list, which will sell at an advance of one hundred per cent. within two years. Second, the very high facial value of Revenue Stamps, preclude the probability of their ever being collected uncancelled thus placing all collectors on an equality. Third, the low prices at which nearly all revenue stamps may be purchased, and the large proportion which may be obtained by simply asking offer great inducement to collectors of limited means.

DIRECTIONS TO PURCHASERS.

Please take particular care in ordering to state that the list is taken from the

Revenue Catalogue.

Orders should be written plainly with the name of county, date of issue, color, value and price, and as our stock is at present limited, we should deem it a favor if customers would send a duplicate list, to be sent in place of any of the original orders we may be out of. We wish it particularly understood that the reason many of the stamps are not priced, is because we do not happen to have them in sufficient stock at present, and cannot lend ourselves to the dishonest practice of offering goods for sale, which we are not likely to be able to supply. As a rule, the prices for those unmarked, would be the same as those immediately before and after. Purchasers are particularly requested to give full name and address each time.

REMITTANCES.—In sending money by Post, always get the amount in as few pieces as possible. When the order amounts to \$3 or upwards, always Register the Letter, or send by P. O. O., the cost of which can be deducted from the amount, or Banker's draft. Unused Revenue Stamps of low denominations will be received from parties residing abroad, in sums not exceeding £1 or \$5, and above that

amount by Banker's draft.

POSTAGE.—All letters must be fully prepaid, and contain sufficient stamps for

return postage.

TERMS, NET CASH.—No discount can be allowed from the prices named in the list, as they will be found as low as it is possible to sell genuine stamps.

Taking these facts into consideration, spaces have only been prepared for well-known antobtainable series of foreign revenue stamps; but by the plen iful distribution of blank pages
throughout the book ample room has been secured for all fiscal stamps hat may be acquired
by the owner. In regard to the emissions of the United States the case is very different, as
nearly every American Philatelist is desirous of obtaining a complete set of the fiscal stamps of
his own country. Therefore great care had been aken to provide space for every samp that
has ever been issued by our own country, with the exception of beer, spirit, and tobaccos samps
which it has been pronounced illegal to collect but as large numbers do collect them sufficient
blank pages have been lett for their accommodation, and taking into consideration their large
size, they can be arranged with equal facility without the aid of lines.
