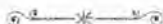

TERMS.



All orders, even the smallest, will be accepted with thanks, but orders for less than 50 cents *must* contain return postage.

Orders for over five dollars are sent registered at our expense.

All orders for Sets, Packages, or Single Stamps, should be accompanied by the full amount in cash.

Such orders will be filled within 24 hours after receipt.

If any of the stamps desired should be out of stock, we return the amount in cash, unless a reserve order is given.

We do not, under any circumstances, make use of Credit Slips.

Full name and address of the writer should be given in every letter.

PAYMENTS can be made in United States or foreign bank notes, postoffice or express money orders and checks. Small amounts can be remitted in unused current stamps, except from Spanish American countries.

Deposit or good references must accompany all orders from parties not known to us. Postal cards will not be considered. Parties who want to see approval sheets only from curiosity, or who intend to buy only if they find \$1 stamps for 10 cents, or whose available funds are less than 25 cents, are respectfully requested not to prey on our time, but leave this department alone.

NOTE.—All stamps are genuine and in good condition.

No set contains more than one stamp of a kind. Varieties of watermarks and perforations are not considered in this list.

Sets marked (*) contain unused stamps only. All others contain mostly used stamps, sometimes mixed with unused ones.

In ordering, the number alone is sufficient.
