P R E F A C E .

In presenting the Ninth Edition of my Catalogue, I would thank collectors, dealers and editors for the very many encomiums passed on my former attempts at compiling a consistent, and, may I hope, correct Postage Stamp Price Catalogue. "The Great Boston Fire" having destroyed all of the type and plates from which the last five editions of this work were printed, it became necessary for me to write the manuscript for this one. None but other compilers of stamp catalogues know what this kind of work is; with numerous "authorities" before you, all of which disagree more or less on some dates, names of colors, and system, nothing remains for the compiler to do but use his judgment on disputed points. If an experience of thirteen years as a Philatelist, eight of which has been as a dealer, has enabled me to render a just verdict in the majority of these disputed points, I am satisfied, for I do not claim this work to be *perfect*, but I *do* claim for it a correctness not to be found in any other Price Catalogue published.

I have noted some "varieties," such as the stamps and envelopes with and without silk threads and on various colored papers; any apparent difference on the face of postal cards; envelopes without any and with superscription in various positions. Perforations, shades and watermarks I have left for some future time.

To the list of Russian Stamps for special offices, I would call special attention, being the only complete Price List of these stamps there is published.

For the typographical part of the work, I would say that every part of the book is printed from new type bought expressly for it, and most of it having been "set up" by myself, but very few typographical errors will be found. Should any such be found, or mistakes or omissions noted, I would be thankful to be notified of such that they may be altered or added, as the case may be, in future editions.

Before closing I would thank the following authors and publishers for the use of their works in the compiling of this one: Overy Taylor, Esq., E. L. Pemberton, Esq., Mons. J. B. Moens, Mons. C. Roussin, Mons. O. B. Levrault, Messrs. H. S. Smith & Co., Messrs. A. Smith & Co., and also the various Postmaster Generals, for official datas furnished me.

Hoping this, my latest Philatelic work, will meet with impartial critics, which I court, and many friends, I remain,

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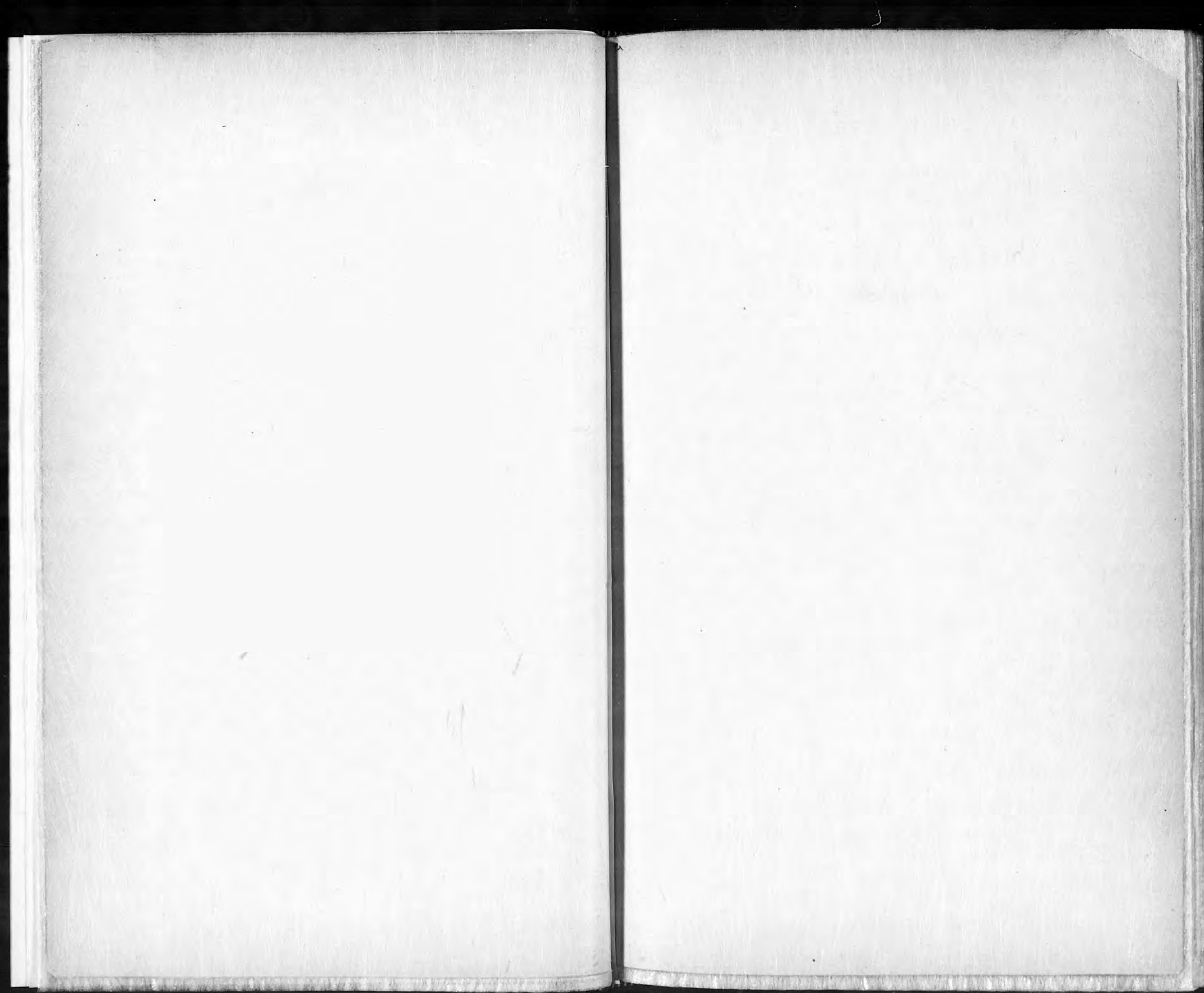

STRAITS SETTLEMENTS.

The same head and inscribed circle has been adopted for the six lowest values of the genuine stamps, but each value has a different design in the angles. The 32 c. and 96 c. are also alike, with the exception of the corner devices.

The originals are engraved in De La Rue's best style, but the forgeries are coarse, and heavy looking. The genuine stamps are always upon paper water-marked c. c. and crown, whereas the forgeries are devoid of watermark.

TWO CENTS. *Forged.* — The details of the genuine have been very carefully copied; so much so, in fact, that it is very difficult to describe the differences between it and the forged. In the latter, the lines do not extend right across the face, there being a space left between the eye and chin; this last slants into the throat, giving the Queen a "bull-necked" expression. There is a well-defined space at the back lower portion of the neck.

Genuine. — The face is lined throughout, and there is only a very little space at the bottom of the neck. The throat is rounded naturally.

4, 6, 8, 12, 24 CENTS. *Forged.* — These are detected with the greatest ease, all the dies being from one matrix, the denomination of value alone being altered. All the angles therefore contain an imitation of the one used in the genuine two cents.

Genuine. — Each stamp has a device in the corners differing from that upon the forged 6 cents here shown.

32 CENTS. *Forged.* — The ornaments in the angles are very coarsely engraved, and are thick and ill-shaped. There is no noticeable space between the line under POSTAGE, and those forming the groundwork. The bottom stroke of the A in POSTAGE runs into the G.

Genuine. — The corner designs are finely done, and are composed of four figures resembling *fleurs-de-lis*, diverging in contrary directions from a very small diamond. There is a white line above the linear ground, and its companion line at foot tapers slightly towards the right.

96 CENTS. *Forged.* — The angles being the same as on the 32 cents, no further description is necessary.

Genuine. — The angles contain a device composed of a pair of crossed links; the remainder of the design is exactly like the previously-named value.

TURKEY.

It really is amusing to find how swindlers, forgers, and other reprobates, sometimes overreach themselves. No doubt the promulgators of the Turkish impositions we are going to describe, made themselves merry over the "greenness" of collectors, and hugged themselves with the thought, that the quartet they were launching upon the philatelic sea were so nicely executed, as to be most difficult of detection. Verily, *facilis descensus Avernæ*, only you oftentimes trip up, and expose the weak part of your armor on your way down.

The poor hireling who prostituted his talents to abet his employers in their nefarious schemes, certainly did his dirty work with much care; but the "good

brothers," unfortunately for themselves, made one grand mistake, which condemns their labels at a glance.

Upon receiving the sheets our risible faculties were called into play, by at once noticing that all the stamps were gummed on the face and postmarked on their backs. After such careful engraving this was indeed a "most impotent conclusion."

From our remarks it will have been understood that we have only seen the forgeries upon thin paper. Although all the Spiro Turkish are now made in the manner we have indicated, there is little doubt but that they will soon come over with the glutinous matter, and the obliteration upon their orthodox places, so *caveat emptor*.

1863. *Crescent and Sign-manual.*

20 PARAS. *Forged*—The crescent upon the left side almost touches the corner ornament. The centre of the sign-manual has an ill-shaped dot within a small blank space. The top of the device in the left-hand lower corner is formed like a double tooth, the right fang almost touching the crescent, whilst the top of the right-hand pattern somewhat resembles an acorn placed sideways. The space containing the figures of value is egg-shaped, the line being unbroken.

Genuine.—Between the crescent and ornament in the left-hand corner there is considerable space, and the centre of the Sultan's signature is solid. The upper parts of both the bottom devices are pretty much alike, the great difference being that the one upon the right-hand is more pointed and bolder than its companion. Value is contained in a design having a likeness to a heart; the dot following the Arabic 2 is placed just under the top stroke of that figure.

1 PIASTRÉ. *Forged*.—The crescent has a jagged point upon the right side. There is no space between the crescent and the stem of *either* of the leaf-like devices beneath it. The bottom of the second Arabic letter (reading from the right) touches the line of the crescent at its base. The figure 1 reaches from the top to the bottom of the oval containing it.

Genuine.—The right side of the crescent tapers to a fine point. The stem of the leaf-ornament on the left touches the crescent, but they are divided by a narrow space upon the right. The second Arabic character touches the top of the crescent, but *not* the bottom; the figure of value does not extend quite to the bottom of the oval.

2 PIASTRÉS. *Forged*.—The left point of the crescent extends higher than the right. The leaf-ornament under the crescent upon the left side touches the frame, that upon the right almost, but does not quite touch it. There are twenty-four circlets composing the bottom of the frame. Numeral is straight at the top.

Genuine.—The crescent is engraved evenly, but if anything, the *right* point is the longest. Both the leaves are at some distance from the frame; which, last, has but twenty-one circles at foot.

5 PIASTRÉS. *Forged*.—The crescent is brought at both ends to an extremely fine point; that upon the left runs into the corner ornaments, and that upon the right very nearly does so. The little semi-circular stroke under the disc holding numeral, does not touch the border. There are boldly engraved diamonds at each angle of the frame. The 5 is very thin at each side of the central space.

Genuine.—There is a space between both of the corner ornaments and the crescent. The stroke below the circle holding value, touches the border. There is a plainly drawn diamond, containing a dot, at the left-hand upper angle of the frame; and there is a badly-shaped one at the opposite side, but the lower corners do not show any. Numeral thick throughout.

VIRGIN ISLANDS.

ONE PENNY. *Forged*.—The lines composing the groundwork of the central oval are uneven and far apart. The cords, from which the lamps are suspended, are very distinct. There is only a slight space above and below ONE PENNY.

Genuine.—Groundwork of oval is finely engraved; the lamp-cords are barely discernible; and the letters in the lower inscription are considerably less in depth than the label containing them.
