If money is enclosed, the letter should always be registered.

Never enclose coin of any kind in a letter, it almost always breaks through the envelope.

Unused U. S. stamps of any denomination will be accepted in any quantity, *but if just as convenient* please send amounts exceeding one dollar in some other way. Postal notes are the most acceptable for small amounts.

FOREIGN.

P. O. Money Orders can be obtained in most foreign countries, and when it is possible this means should be adopted.

Bank of England notes taken at \$4.87 to the £.

Bank notes of other countries accepted at the current rates of exchange.

Unused European stamps *are not accepted*, except those of England and Germany, at 24 cents to the shilling and 23 cents to the mark.

Unused stamps of all countries, except those in Europe, will be accepted in small sums if the lower denominations are sent.

All orders under 50 cents must contain 2-cent stamp for return postage.

We are not responsible for letters lost in transit.

When ordering single stamps always send a supplementary order of at least 40 per cent.; you may then be sure of getting just what you want.
