APPROVAL SHEET DEPARTMENT.

SHEETS, COMMISSION, REFERENCES.

Subject to the following provisions I will send out four grades of sheets, viz:

GRADE A. Intended primarily for agents, and containing foreign stamps of great variety at prices ranging from 1 cent to 50, also the commoner varieties of U. S. revenues. No references are necessary, but those who send them will get larger and better selections. Parents' or teachers' are sufficient. Commission, 50 per cent.

GRADE B. Intended primarily for collectors, containing foreign stamps, rare and desirable specimens only. New issues, special bargains etc. Sent only against good references. Net sheets furnished when requested, otherwise, Commission, 33 1-3 per cent.

GRADE C. Containing United States stamps only, ordinary quality, revenues and envelopes. Sent only against references. Commission, 30 per cent.

GRADE D. Containing United States stamps only, best quality. These will be sent only to parties known to me, or who have previously traded with me, or to those who can refer me to parties to whom I have previously sent these sheets, or who may provide a cash deposit of at least \$3.00 Commission, 20 per cent.

Parties who have previously traded with me of course need no references. Parties outside the United States can get *no sheets* except against cash deposit.

TIME.

Sheets may be retained until the time set on the return slip which accompanies each selection. Arrangements for longer retention may be made on application. Serious delay — if unexplained or unnecessary — will forfeit an agency.

PRIZES.

Every person ordering from this list *at retail* any stamps to the amount of \$1.00 *at one time* and every agent whose remittance for sales from sheets of Grade A exceeds one fifth the *gross* value of the sheets sent him, will receive free a stamp catalogued at from five cents to one dollar, *provided* that orders are accompanied by cash, and that sheets are returned when due.

EXCHANGE AND PURCHASE.

I will take good stamps of any country in exchange for stamps from my approval sheets at prices marked allowing one-half catalogue price therefor. Special arrangements made for the exchange of the rarer and more desirable stamps. All sent me in exchange are subject to my right of rejection.

I will pay high cash prices for *rare* stamps from Canada, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Newfoundland, *all* British Colonies, and the old German States.
