No references are necessary, but those who send them will get larger and better selections. Parents' or teachers' are sufficient.

GRADE B. Intended primarily for collectors, containing foreign stamps, rare and desirable specimens only. New issues, special bargains etc. Sent only against good references. Net sheets furnished when requested, otherwise, Commission, 33 1-3 per cent.
GRADE C. Containing United States stamps only, ordinary quality, revenues and envelopes. Sent only against references.

Commission, 30 per cent.
GRADE D. Containing United States stamps only, best quality. These will be sent only to parties known to me, or who have previously traded with me, or to those who can refer me to parties to whom I have previously sent these sheets, or who may provide a cash deposit of at least $\$ 3.00$ Commission, 20 per cent.

Parties who have previously traded with me of course need no references. Parties outside the United States can get no shects except against cash deposit.
