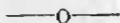

If not, I think it will be a good investment to take one or two of the leading papers, as it will keep you posted on new issues, forgeries, stamp swindlers, and 1,001 things pertaining to stamps and stamp collecting that you would not know otherwise.

The *Stamp World*, published by F. L. Mills, Cincinnati, O., is now in its 7th year of publication, is next to the oldest in America and costs but 25c. a year.

The *Philatelic Journal of America*, is published at St. Louis, Mo. Started out 1 year ago as the leading journal in America. Is very ably edited and holds its own. I do not regret the 50c. which I spent for this year's numbers.

The *Empire State Philatelist*, hails from New York City. T. C. Watkins & Co., P. O. Box 1716, are the proprietors and publishers. It is an 8-page paper with a very neat and attractive colored cover. The subscription is but 25c., per year. Messrs. Watkins & Co. claim a circulation of 2,500 copies per month. I should like to see it 25,000 and will do all in my power to boom it along. Send for a sample copy. You will like it. A story entitled "The Strange Disappearance of a Stamp Collection," was started in the March number, and promises to be very interesting.
