In other values stamps are more highly ornamented; bust is in octagonal frame, value in figures and bill stamp above, canada and value in words below. This issue was engraved by the American Bank Note Co., of New York.

Third Issue, 1868.

DESCRIPTION.—Shape, rectangular; Design, in first ten varieties, likeness of Queen Victoria, seated with chin resting on right hand, in nearly square frame; figures of value and CANADA above, BILL STAMP and value in words below. In other values likeness is in circular frame,

inscription above and value in figures and words below, except in "dollar" varieties on which likeness is in belt circle containing inscription, with value above and below.

Besides revenue stamps for Tobacco—the cut, plug, and twist,—Cigars, and Cigarettes, 11 ere are also stamps used for Snuff and for Petroleum, which may be given in a future edition of this work if interest in them warrants.
