CONSTITUTION
OF THE
SPRINGFIELD

Philatelic Association

ADOPTED NOVEMBER 21, 1879.

ARTICLE I.

This society shall be called the Springfield Philatelic Association.

ARTICLE II.

SEC. 1. The officers shall be as follows: President, Vice President, and a Secretary and Treasurer, who shall perform their regular parliamentary duties. The Vice President shall also act as Librarian.

SEC. 2. Officers shall be elected at the last regular meeting in March, June, September and December, and installed the first meeting of the following month.

SEC. 3. The officers shall constitute an executive committee, who shall assign all subjects to be read or discussed before the society. They shall receive and report on all applications for membership.

ARTICLE III.

SEC. 1. Any person over fifteen years of age shall be eligible for membership.

ARTICLE III.

SEC. 2. Members shall be voted upon by ballot, and a three-fourths vote shall be necessary to elect.

SEC. 3. The entrance fee shall be seventy five cents.

SEC. 4. Corresponding members shall be elected in the same manner as regular members, and shall pay an annual fee of fifty cents. They shall receive free, all publications of the society.

ARTICLE IV.

SEC. 1. Regular meetings shall be held every two weeks.

SEC. 2. Special meetings may be held at the call of the executive committee.

SEC. 3. Three members shall constitute a quorum.

ARTICLE V.

Fines shall be imposed by the executive committee as follows:

For unnecessary absence,	10 cents.
" " tardiness,	5 "
" disrespectful language or conduct,	5 "
" failing to vote,	5 "
" illegal voting,	10 "
" failing to perform duties assigned,	10 "
" keeping a book more than two weeks,	10 "

ARTICLE VI.

This constitution can only be amended by a unanimous vote.
