# CONSTITUTION 

OF THE

## SPRINGFIELD



KDOPTED KOYEMBER R1, 1879.

## ARTICLE I.

This society shall be called the Springfield Philatelie Association.

## ARTICLE II.

Sec. 1. The offleers shall be as follows: President. Vice President, and a Secretary and Treasurer, who shall perform their regular parliamentary duties. The Vice President shall also act as Iibrarian.

Sec. 2. Officers shall be elected at the laft regular meeting in March, June, September aud December, and installed the first meeting of the following month.

Sec. 3. The officers shall constitute an executive committee. who shall assign all subjects to be read or discussed before the society. They shall receive and report ori all applications for membership.

ARTICLE III.
SEc. 1. Any person over fifteen years of age shall be eligible for membership.

## ARTICLE III.

sec. 2. Members shall be voted upon by ballot, and a three-fourths vote shall be necessary to elect.
Scc. 3. The entrance fee shall be seventy five cents.
scc. 4. Corresponding members shall be elected in the same manner as regular members, and shall pay an annual fee of lifty cents. They shall receive free, all publications of the society.

## AR'TICLE IV.

Sec. 1. Hegular meetings shall be held every two weekis.
Svc. 2. Special meetings may be held at the call of the executive committee.
Sec. 3. 'Ihree inembers shall constitute a quorum. ARTICLE V.
Fines shall be imposed by the executive committee as follows: For umneressary absence,

## ARTLCLE VI.

This constitution can only be amended by a unanimous vote.
