PREFACE.

In presenting this, my first Price-List, to the Collectors of Postage Stamps, I desire to call attention to some special features.

The blank pages, alternating with the list of single stamps and sets are designed for Memoranda of "Wants," and orders sent and will be found very convenient.

The countries are arranged alphabetically, and opposite the name of each the price of a set and the number contained in it is given.

When several stamps appear on the same line, the price given is so much for each.

This condensed Price-List has been made up from stamps *actually in stock*, but besides these I have many other varieties not named therein.

In ordering always send an extra list of say, fifty per cent. more, as the stock varies constantly, and stamps sold out cannot always be replaced, like brown muslin or sugar.

Although my prices are much below standard catalogue prices I make the following special offer: For 50 cents you may select single stamps amounting to 62 cents, for \$1.00 to the value of \$1.30; and for \$2.00, \$2.75.

Sets and Packets are strictly net.

Amounts under \$1.00 may be remitted in unused U. S. Stamps. Foreign correspondents will please remit in lowest denominations of their respective countries.

*Postage must be added to all orders less than 25 cents.
