## COMPILER'S NOTE.

In presenting this Directory the compiler has only to state that the same is incomplete as far as names of collectors are concerned, but has no apology to make as he spent unlimited time in correspondence and dollars in postage and advertising to secure names in a number of towns, but without success, such as Fort Worth, Palestine, Laredo, Tyler, Marshall, and several others of under 5,000 population. Again, other cities and towns are well represented, such as San Antonio 99 names; Dallas 33 names; Austin 18 names; Galveston 17 names; Houston 13 names; Waco 13 names, etc. The total number of names of collectors contained in this Directory is 342, and of dealers is 9. A number of blank spaces have been left for additions and corrections. A second edition will probably be published in 1897, and it is hoped that it will be more complete.
