The figures of value on the U. S. special delivery stamps of 1894 are shaded, while those on the earlier blue stamps are plain.



The cancellation on Belgian stamps, consisting of a narrow band with diamond shaped figures, is that of the postal savings banks. Such stamps have never been used for postage, and are thus about on a par with the punched Spanish stamps, which, however, are punched to denote use in telegraphing.

In 1887, the 90 cent 1869 could be had unused for \$2.00. Now it is worth in the neighborhood of \$40.00. A set of Treasury stamps could be had for about \$.25 and the set of Executive for \$.80.
