## TERMS.

---

Net cash with each order.

Remittances should be made by post-office money order, draft or U. S. currency bills in registered letters.

Postage stamps will be accepted only for sums less than \$1.00.

Letters of value should always be registered. We do not hold ourselves responsible for letters lost in transit.

**EXCESS ORDERS:**—It will be well to send an order for more than the amount of the remittance, so that stamps may be sent to the full amount of the sum received.

Letters of inquiry and small orders must contain a stamp for return postage.

**WHOLESALE.**—We would be pleased to quote you wholesale prices Hawaiian stamps if you are a dealer.

Discounts 25 to 40 per cent. off catalogue prices according to varieties.

**APPROVAL TRADE.**—The system of sending stamps mounted upon sheets and in books out to collectors on approval has been very much abused by both dealers and collectors.

We have not the time to devote to petty approval sheet business, and further selections will not be sent to parties whose net remittances are below 25 cents, unless there is a reasonable excuse. The trade of the class of people who are in the habit of requesting sheets to buy a few cents worth of stamps is respectfully declined.

Unless you have an open account, or are known to us, good business or bank references are required.

We shall take pleasure in devoting our time and attention to collectors who are buyers of stamps, and are always glad to make new friends.

**OUR APPROVAL STOCKS.**—Customers are requested to give us some idea of what they want, specifying what are wanted; whether they prefer used or unused, and about how high priced stamps they buy. These particulars will assist us in suiting them.

More liberal offers may appear to be made by others, but when price and

condition are considered our stamps will be found to be cheaper. We sell stamps as cheap as it is possible for genuine stamps to be sold.

WE cannot assume to fill any orders for **SINGLE STAMPS**, unless accompanied with the cash at catalogue prices.

ALL prices quoted below are for cash only, but are subject to change during the year. No Provisional Government stamps are now on sale at the post-office. They were all destroyed by order of the Legislature, January 28, 1897.

**CANCELLED** Hawaiian stamps of high denominations are very rare and seldom obtained in Hawaii.

Every stamp sold by us is guaranteed as a genuine original.
