The chapter blealing with waricties of restricted franking frower hats been added, as many collectors are meteresed in them, but we do met consider their presence necessary in a collection, although they are occasion ally of value, in throwing at side light on the history of al dic.

The general plan of the catalogue maty be hathered from the Table of Contents.

Unfortunately but very little information from the ntticial records at Sumerset House has yet been made publice ant offical althoght the necessary permission has been courte reacomas. mosly granted by the Baand of Inand Revenuc, it is to be feased that a lome periend must clapse before
 decided mot to delisy ant lomger the publication of the presemt editum, which hiss heen under consideration alreaty nearly twor y"ars.

In the absence of a demeral philatelic index, very few reforences to other pathlicalions hase heen mate ; in fate there is very titte information of valtace to low fore as bitherto the subject bas always been treated froms the puint of view of the stationery collcator and the variations in the stanps left seserely alome keforence has chictly luen made to the tingiond

Period of use.-The Mulready stationery met with ridicule from the public, and the unsold stocks were withdatson from the Post Offices in 1841 and destroyed. An immense number of caricatures appeared during that perioh, for a description of which reforence is reconmended to The Malrady Envelopa and its Caricatures (by Major Evans, published 1891).

Dis-Numbers. - bach die hat a separate number, which wis engraved just over the rectangulan design inscribed "1POSTAGB:." Twelve dies placed tognether formed a plate for printing purposes. The following die-rambers atre known:

## I.-THE GENERAI. OR ". ENVEIOIE'" STAMPS.


These stamps are of ten values, and were used principally fur stamging enselopes, efter-sheets and varinus other postal coners and papers. The dad value was alse used for stamping pest cards and certificates of posting; the Gw. lod. and 1/- for telegram forms, and the 2d. and td., during at short pertiod. on registration envelapes.

The tirst dies * were of the values of Id. and ed., and were emphened in $18+1$ tostampenveloges and beter-shects sold by the post aflice. In 18.55 the right to mowide their awn paper and enselopes for stamping was conceded to the public. three new rallues of tal., fid. and 1/. being broughe into use and subsequenty athers. Firam 1 sins till recently all the dies employed were dated. but lattery this paratice has been abatudened. It is worthy of note that the fid., 10d. and $1 /$ values are of the same type as the three cmluessed adhesite stamps issued in 1847-5t.

## halfPEnny.

For the first few years this value was used exclusively in stamping post cards all Somerset House at the order of the public, who supplied the material. In October 1877, and agation in December 18\$0, it wats employed in stamping certhicates of posting. From 1884 to $189{ }^{2}$, the dies of this value were not employed. but since this batter date the colour hats been changed and they are new usd for various purposes.


## I. P08T OFFICE 8ERIE8 (1893-1802).

The unnumbered dics were emplosed solely for stamping enselopes sold through the agency of the Post oftiee. The warious dics are quite indistinguishable. ats they tery rately show any sifns of wear.

Marks of Wear.- Most dics mat be identified by means of shight defects in the design or by moks of wear, which sonmetimes become very plan. The latter are of course absent foom catly impressions. which gencrally. however, hate the compersatemg adsantage of clearer die-numbers.

Colour and Papir.-The colour is almost invariably a very pale pink, but sumuc of the Certiticates of losting Were stamped in a brighter shate De Die 1. cat alane be ohtained on proper. but it is quite easy to thin down the impresions on card, ats the hayers of paper forming the card peel oft readily without injuring the im. pression, protided of comse the aperation is not performed ton liberally.

Harks of Wear. - Cammencing wath dies 19 and 21 at system ol ine stecling the dies was introfluced. Whenever a die becance worn, it was recosted, thus enabling it to he used for athore while longer, although of coursce its life was by no means doubled. In the case of some dies, this process may have been repeated several
times, and each time a difierent set of matis of wear developed. Whereas dies $15,16,17,18$ and 20. libe their predecessers. were only in use three ar four months. dies 19 and 21 to 38 were cmployed for periods ranging from one to three geatm fas far as can be judged from the dattes of protmathed copies-ofticial information is unfortanately ats present unatailable). Commencing with die 39 the period of employment is again reduced to less than a jear, and but few of these later dies hase becon met with showing noore than one set of marlis. Since 1878 the Stomford Mererry hats ceased to make use of thes special stamp but is still allowed to use " pre-cancelled " wrappers. These are ordinary wrappers, frambed accasionally with adhesive stamps but usually with an impressed stamp, the stamps being cancelled before the wrappers are used, with il special type of post. mark only used in the Stamford Mersury oftice. These varictics therefore correspond to the "preecancelled stamps " so well-inown in the United States and Cianada.


The bd. brown is bomon in both types, and botls the Queen's Head and King's Head barictes of the dd. green mewspaper stamp probably exists, in addition to certain of the adhesives in use during the same period, but they cannot rank as distinct stamps.

## STAMPS OF RESTRICTED FRANKING POWER.

## I.-STAMPS RESTRICTED TO USE BY CERTAIN FIRM8.

From 18.57 to 1889 , envelopes and wrappers could be embossed at Somerset House with a ring inseribud with name, address, and trade surrounding the ordinary envelope stamp. Seseral firms arailed themselves of this privolege principally as a means of advertisement. The best fonown are perhaps Messes. W. H. Smith and Son. Smith, Elder and Co.. and Grindlay and Co. (•• The Home News "). In the case of these tirms the ring was aftixed to the stamping die, afted the ingression made at the sande time with the same ink and conseguently in the sathe shade of colour. Wams other firms however obtained envelopes which had heen stamped in the ordinary way, and afterwards privately printed a ring round the stamp. These varieties may generally lie distinguished by the fact that the ring is in a different shate tothe stamp, and oncasionally overlaps it. The envelope stamps which may be found with officially printed rings are those of the values of 1 d. . I $\mathrm{h}_{\mathrm{h}} \mathrm{d} . .2 \mathrm{~d} ., 2 \mathrm{~d} .$. $3 d ., 4 d ., 6 d$, and $1 /$ in use during the above-mentimed periond. Three or four copies of the dif. envelope are also known, and are probably proofs.
