## PREFACE.

**T**HREE different styles of type are employed for printing the names in the List of Dealers in this DIRECTORY. The names in SMALL CAPITALS are those of firms who have returned our Enquiry Form, and they, with the advertisers, may therefore be taken as representing the really "active" section of the stamp dealing community in the United Kingdom. The names in the black "De Vinne" type are those of advertisers whose announcements appear in this edition. It will be found that they include many of the best known and most reliable firms of the day, and we would respectfully bespeak for them our readers' careful perusal and a liberal share of their patronage.

The names in ordinary Roman type (the same as the addresses) are those of dealers who have failed to return our Forms; as the Forms addressed to them were not sent back by the Post Office we can only assume that the dealers are still in business.

Criticisms on the score of "incompleteness" are occasionally levelled at the DIRECTORY by reviewers and others. In reply to such, we may remind our critics that some dealers have specially requested us to omit their names; in those cases obviously we cannot include them, however much we may wish to do so. A few of our Forms have again reached us without any signature or other indication of the sender.

Of the names contained in the last Edition, over thirty have been removed for various reasons, and about the same number of alterations and corrections have been made in addresses. In addition to this, some seventy new names now appear—surely a healthy indication of the present state of the stamp business!

Whilst thanking all who have contributed to the success of the present Edition of the DIRECTORY, we would repeat that we are always pleased to receive suggestions calculated to improve the work or to increase its value to the philatelic public.

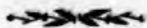

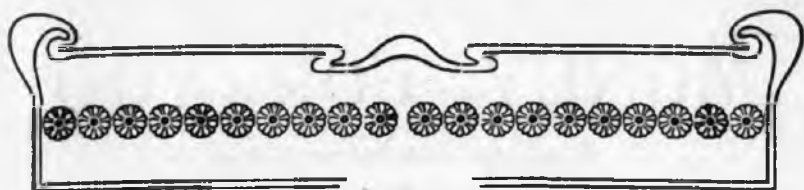
