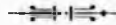

PREFACE.

THREE different styles of type are employed for printing the names in the List of Dealers in this **DIRECTORY**.

The names in **SMALL CAPITALS** are those of firms who have returned our Enquiry Form, and they, with the Advertisers, may probably be taken as representing the really "active" section of the stamp dealing community in the United Kingdom. The names in the black "De Vinne" type are those of advertisers whose announcements appear in this edition. It will be found that they include many of the best known and most reliable firms of the day, and we would respectfully bespeak for them our readers' careful perusal and a liberal share of their patronage.

The names in ordinary Roman type (the same as the addresses) are those of dealers who have failed to return our Forms; as the Forms addressed to them were not sent back by the Post Office we can only assume that the dealers are still in business. Some of our Forms again reached us without any signature or other indication of the sender.

Of the names contained in the last Edition, forty-three have been removed for various reasons, and numerous alterations and corrections have been made in addresses. In addition, over forty new names now appear for the first time—of dealers who have started in business since the last **DIRECTORY** appeared.

The "List of Pictorial Postcard Dealers" is omitted from the present Edition; its popularity did not appear to be sufficient to justify its continuance as a feature of the **DIRECTORY**. We may, however, resume its publication in a future issue if it should seem desirable to do so.
