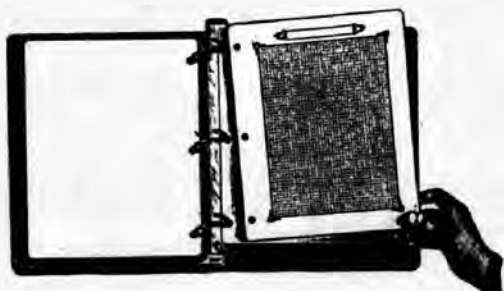

REPRESENTATIVES!**

EACH year, in the preparation of NUNN'S DIRECTORY, we send out Correction Forms to all the persons and firms whose names appeared in the previous Edition, and to other parties whom we have reason to believe have started in the business during the year; but only about ten per cent. of the Forms are returned to us. 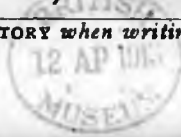
