Occupying the northern part of the continent of America, is a conntry which is deatined some day to become one of the most populous and prosperous countries on the face of the globe. It extends from the Atlantic Ocean on the east to the Pacific on the west, and reaches from the mighty St. Lawrence, and the chain of Great Lakes, on the south, to the Arctic ocesn on the north. This immense tract of land contains about $3,500,000$ square miles, and is equal in size to the whole of Europe. The soil is very fertile, and millions of acres are yet uncultivated; it is also rich in minerals and timber, and the rivers, lakef and forests abound with fish and game. The population is $6,000,000$, and they are a hardy, industrious and prosperous people. In aupport of this statement we have only to look at the immense progress they have made during the last few years, and at the gigantic public works they have undertaken and carried to a succensful issue, chief of which is the Canadian Pacific Railway, a great highway extending from the Atlantic to the Pacific, a distance of over 3,000 miles, binding together with an iron band the eeveral provinees.

The Goverament holds out many inducementa to intending settlers, piving them frue grants of land, and assisting in many other ways. It
has a first-class Postal System, and the Money-order and Savings Bank Branch is said to be the most complete in the world.

To most of our readers the Postage Stampe of this country will be of more interest than the people, or anything else connected with it. Being a British colony, for many years the Post Office Departnient was controlled by the Post Master General of Great Britain, but in 1851 Canada wad given control of her own postal syatem, and one of the firat acts. after the change, was the iesuing of Postage Stamps. They were of three demonibations, 3 pence, 6 pence, and 12 pence, and were ongraved and printed in New York. They may be deacribed as follows:-The 3 pence is oblong in ahape, and has in the centre a beaver surmounted by a crown, and the letters "V.R." Around this in an oval horizontal frame is the inscription in capital letters of "Cansda Postage," "Three Pence," and in each corner the figure "33." Color, red and red brown. The 6 pence has the picture of the Prince Consort, in perpendicular ob. long frame, with the inscription "Canada Postage" above "Six Pence" below, and a figure " 6 " in each corner. Color, purple and black lilac. The 12 pence is a very rare stamp, and was evidently an error on the part of the designer, as atamps representing the same value for other conntries are issaed as "One Shilling" and not " 12 Pence." This stamp beara a crowned head of Queen Victoris, facing to left, enclosed in a perpendicular oval frame, "Gagada Packet Postage," at top, "Twelve Pence" at bottom, value in figures at each corner; color, black. In 1855 another stamp was issued, viz., the 10 pence. It was ornamented with the head of Jacques Cartier, facing to right, in perpendicular oval frame, "Canada Poatage" above, "Ten Pence" below, " 8 d . stg," in both upper corners, " 10 d . cy," in both lower corners Color, deep blae.

In 1857 two other stamps were issued viz., the half penny, and seven pence half-penng. The half-penny has head of Queen Victoria to left in oval frame, "Canada Postage" above, "One Half Penny" below; color, pink. The 71 pence bears a picture of Queen Victoria aimilar to that on the 12 pence, in oval frame, "Canada Packet Poatage "above, "Six Pence, Sterling" below; "6d atg," in the upper and lower left hand corner "7hd. cy," in the upper and lower right hand corners ; color, green. The above stampe were all unperforated.

In 1858 the half-penny, 3 pence, and 6 pence were issued, perforated.
In 1859, owing to the changing of the currency from $£$. S. D. to and cts., a new set of stampe was issued, consisting of five values, the
designs of these stamps being the same as the previons issue, the value of each being expressed in cents. The 1 cent aame design as the halfpenay, the 5 cents same as 3 pence, the 10 cent same as 6 pence, the $12 \frac{1}{3}$ cent same as 7at penny, and 17 cent asme as the 10 pence. All were perforated.

In 1864 a two cent $\begin{aligned} & \text { tamp was iesued, bearing head of Victoris to }\end{aligned}$ left, in oval frame, "Canada Postage" above, "Two Centa" below, and a figure " 2 " in each corner. In 1867 the Dominion of Canada was formed, and in 1868 a new set of stamps was issued, of the following denominations, they all, with ode exception, being of similar design, though of different denominations : $\frac{1}{2}$ cent, black; 1 cent, brown red; 2 cent, green ; 3 cent, red ; 6 cent, brown; 12 h cent, blue; and 15 cent, violet. and may be described as follows:-Head of Queen Victoris to right, in circle ; "Canada Postage" above, value in figures and lettere at bottom.

In 1869-70 another set of stampa was ibsued of bame designa as previous issue but somewhat amaller in aize, the denominations being the bame, with the addition of a ten cent, pink.

In 1875 thres denominations of Registered stamps were isatud, two cent orange; 5 cent, preen; and eight cent, blue. They were oblong in shape, having value printed in letters across each enf; the value in figures, in both upper corners and across the face of the stamp in various sized type; the worde "Canada Registered Letter Stamp"

In 1879 the stamp was isaued called "Officislly Sealef" stamp; it was naed in the Dead Letter Office at Ottawa only; was brown in color, and had the following insaription printed in two carved and one otraigbt line across it, "Post Office, Canada, Officially Sealed, Dead Letter Office."

Stamped Envelopes ware first issued in 1860 and ware of two denominations, viz: 5 cents and 10 cents. The color of the 5 cent stamp was vermilion and that of the 10 cent chocolate. They were printed on laid paper of good quality which was watermarked with lines running diagonally from left to right, and these lines were oroges by the letters in large capitals " Ca ." and below this "P.O.D." Both denominstions were the same size, $34 \times 573$. Very few of these were ueed, the public not appreciating their convenience; and even to-day very few stamped envelopes are ased in Canada.

In 1877 two other values were issued viz: stampe, 1 cent, blue, and 3 oent, red. They were printed on laid paper, watermarked with diagonal
lines. The 1 cent were $3 \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$; there being only onesize of this denomina tion. There were two sizes of the 3 ceat, known as No. 1 and 2; No. 1 has the qame size as the 1 cent viz: $3 x$ 馬. No, 2, was a little larger.


There are several elight variations in the kinds of paper used, but they are so small as to be unworthy of notice. All the Canada onvelopes are printed on white paper.

Newspaper wrappers ware first issued in 1875 and like the evelopea, there were very few of them used. They are all printed on sheets of paper $4 \mathrm{~g}_{\mathrm{g}} \times 10 \mathrm{~m}$, and from three different Dies and on a number of varieties and shades of paper, a very complets list of whioh will be found further on with correct dates attached. For convenience we will number the Dies 1, 2, and 3. Die 1 was used from 1875 to 1882, Die 2, from 1882 to 1887. and Die 3, from 1887 to the present time.

Postal cards were first issued in 1877. They were printed on heavs paper, $3 \times 4$ 年, and were of two values, 1 cent, blue, for domestic ase, and 2 cent, green, for use to the United Kingdom. The 1 cent blue may be described as follows:-Head of Queen to right in circle surronnded by a fancy frame with the words "One Cent" below; to the left of this and reaching acros. the top of the card in capital lettera is "Canads Post Card," and below this in small type "The address only to be written on this side," and below this on the left hand side the word "To" which is intended to be followed by the address, for which purpoes there are three ruled lines. The above is contained in an ornamented frame encloing a apane $2 \$ \mathrm{zt}$.

The 2 cent. green, is about the same as the 1 cent, exoept that it has the words "Canada Poat Card" in a carved line and in addition below it the wor.? "To United Kingdom." They were engraved by the British Americen Bank Note Co, of Montreal. Some of the 1 cent, blue, have "British American Bank Note Co., Montreal and Ottawa,' on them. The remson Ottawa was added was that owing to a fire in the above mentioned company's establishment, the printing of said cards was done at Ottawa.

In 1881 a new 2 cent card for foreign use was ibsued, the nee of such cards having been anthorized by the Poatal Uninn Treaty. The design was nimilar to the "United Kingdom" card and the aame color viz., green.

In 1883, two new varieties of carde were issued, they being a little larger than tha former igaues, 3x54. The design of the gtamp was anme
as die 2, of the wrappers in use at the time. There was no border, simply a plain card with the same inscription, omitting the word "oply ' from the second line. The words "Canada Pont Card "were on a curved scroll. The one cent was light blue, and the two cent reply was black.

In 1886 the two cent reply was issued in error, with the stamp in the upper left hand corner instead of the apper right hand corner. They are quite scarce as the Gorernment stopped the issue and only a faw were put in circulation.

In 1887 two new cards were issued of the amme degign as the previous issue having the stamp same as Die 3 of the wrappera. They were one cent, blue, and 2 sent reply, black. In 1888 the two cent reply wat changed to a very dark shade of green. Many errors in printing have have occurred auch as having been printed twice on the aame card, zc. They are prized by collectors as oddities

## OANADA BIL工 STAMPS.

Bill Stamps were first issued in 1864 and were used continuously from that date till 1882 when the Act authonzing the collection of this tax was repesled There was three different issues during this time. Tbe first iseue was in 1864. These stampa were all of similar deaign. nearly square, with the head of the Quean to the left in a perpendicular oval. at top of same "Bill Stamp," below "Canada;" in the upper cornera the value in figures, and across the bottom the value in words; color, blue.

We have ceen nearly every value of this issue unperforated, but have sacertained that the reason of this was that an occasional sheet was unintentionally not perforated, and, therefore, unperforated specimens may be collected as oddities. The One, Two or Three dollars were somewhat larger than the lower valines

The second isaue took place in 1865 and may be darcribed as follows:-The 1. 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 cent were scarlet colored, head of the Queen to left in perpendicular oval ; across the top of stamp in two slightly curved lines the words "Canada Bill Stamp." across the bottom the value in worde, ard just above this, at either side, the value in figures.

The 10. 20. 30, 40 and 50 cents were blue, head of Queen to left in octagonal freme. value in upper corners, in figures; "Bill Stamp." above in curved line ; "Canads," and value in words in two lines across the bottom. The One dollar has head of Queen to left in a circle with the words "Bill Stamp," above and "Canada" below; the value in figures in upper corners, scross the top between value in figures "One" and across the bottom "One Dollar." The two and three dollars were of simular desigu.

The third is8ue occurred in 1869 . The 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 cent were of similar design, bat of various colors, and may be described as follows:-head and shoulders of Queen with widow's cap and chin reating on right hand, in frame having three rectangular sides, the top being slightly curved; the word "Canada" above and "Bill Stamp" below, value in figures in both upper corners and in words across the bottom.

The $10,20,30,40$ and 50 cents were blue, with bust of Queen in same position as in Iower values, enclosed in a circle. Above circle the words, "Canads Bill Stamp," below circle at either aide the value in figures and across the bottom value in words. The one drllar bas bust of Queen same as the uther valuen of this issue, enclosed in a circle. Within the circle at the top "Canada," and at the bottom "Bill Stamp." In the centre at the top the word "dollar," and on both sides of it the " $\$ 1$ "in figures, and aaross the bottom the value in words.

The Two and Three dollars were of similar design. We hspe zeen the one dollar of this issue unperforated, but as it was also unused and ungummed we consider it simply a proof.

## SUPRE最E COURT BTAMPS.

These atampa I believe are the least known of all the Revenue Stampe of Canads

In 1876 the inspection of Weights and Measures and Gas Meters as wr.ll as the rexular duties of the above Court were placed under its control and during the same year three sets of stamps were issued for the purpose of collecting the revenues under its control. These stamps are divided into three classes, viz: Supreme Court Stamps proper. Gas Inspection and Weights and Measuren Stamps. The Sapreme Court Stamps proper may be described as follows: length, three inches, breadth one and one-quarter inches, perforated; color, blue shaded, from very dark to light ; across the top and bottom in an oblong frame is the value in figures; in the centre, but much nearer the top than bottom in a circle about an inch in diameter, is the Quean's head, crowned; at the top of the circle the word "Canada" and at the bottom "Law Stamp "; between the head and the value at the bottom, on a scroll is the registered number in red and just below this on a curved seroll, the value in words.

These atamps are finely engraved and I consider them the most beautiful stampe ever issued by the Canadian Government.

There are six values, 10 cent, 20 cent, 25 cent, 50 cent, $\$ 100$ and $\$ 50$ They are all of aimilar design.

Gas Inspection Stamps are two inches long and three-quarters of an inch wide and perforated. They may be deacribed as as follows: color bright blae; across the ceutre ta blank space in which the repistered number is printed in red. I may here add that in each value the registered number aesma to be printed with different type of various sizes Above the registered number we have the word "Gas" and below "Inspection." The upper part of the stamp is occupied by so crown surmounted by an irregular frame; in the centre of the lower part is an oblung frame in which is the value in figures, surrounded by engraving similar to that geen on bank notes around the values. There are nine values, 5 cent, 25 cent, 50 cent, $81.00, \$ 1.50, \$ 2.00, \$ 3.00, \$ 400$ and $\$ 10.00$.

They are all of same design and color. The Weights and Measures Stamps are the same size, perforation, and derign as the Gas Inspection with the following changes, viz: "Weights \&" above the blank space in the centre and "Measures" below. The registered number is sometimes printed in blue and a ometimes in red; it is also sometimes printed acruss the top of the stamp instead of in the centre; also various suzed type is used in printing these numbers.

There are eleven values and thirteen varieties made up as follows:1 cent, 2 cent, 5 cent. 10 cent, 15 cent. 20 cent. 30 cent. 50 cent, 81.00 , $\$ 150$ and $\$ 2.00$ all in black, and 1 cent and 2 cent in blue.

The Supreme Court Stamps proper are used on writs, summanses, \&c, issued by the Supreme Court.

Gas Inspection stampe are uned on certiticatesissued by the Inspector certifying to the correctisess of the metres.

Weights and Measures stampa are used on certificates given by the Inapector certifying that thescales and measures he has tested are correct.

## 'THE PROVINCES.

BRITIGE COLU BRLA AND VANOOUVER'G ISLAND.
This province issued its first postage stamp in 1861 and it may be deacribed as follows.-Head of Queen to left in centre of stamp "British Columbis" at top "Vancouvers Island" at bottom, both in two lines; on left side "Postage" and on right side in two lines "Two Pence Half Pengy," color pink. In 1864 a three pences stamp was issued for use in British Columbia only. An oval scroll occupied the centre of the stamp and on the scrol! "British Colombia Postage, Three Pence," in the space enclosed by the acroll the Roman numeral V, surmounted by a crown.

In 1863 sheets of stampe were printed from the above plate and surcharged with values in cents.
In 1865 two stamps were issued for use in Vancouver's Island alone ; They had head of Queen to left in circle. "Vancouver's Island" above and the value in words below.

## MANTTOBA.

The only stamps issued by this province is a series of Law Stamps. They are all of sixilar deaign being oblong in shape. In the centre a tigure of Justice holding a pair of balances in her uplifted hand. The 10 . 20,25 and 50 cent have the words "Manitobas Law Stamp" in two curved lines at the top and the value at the bottom.

The 1 and 2 dollars have the value across the top; below the value in a curved line "Manitoba " and across the bottom "Law Stamp."

Each value is surcharged by various letters which signify for what particular purpose the stamn ib used. C. F. Court Fees; L. S. Law Society ; J. F. Judges Fees ; B. F., Bailif's Fees.

## NEW BRUNSWICK.

The first issue of Postage Stamps in this province took place in 1851. They were lozenge shaped, and showed a crown in centre with a robe at top and bottom, a shamrock on the left and a thistle on the right. On the two upper sides "New Brunswick, on the two lower sides the value in words and "Postage," There were three values all of similar design. The six pence is sometimes met with cut*in balf and used for three pence.

In 1860 a new set of stamps in decimal currency was issued. They were of various designs, all having the words "New Brunswick Postage" and the valve in words round an aval, enclosing on the one ceut a train of cars; the five ceat, head of Queen; ten cent, head of Queen ; twelve-aud-a-half, a ship; seventeen cent, the Prince of Wales ; slao the value in figures in esch corner.

In 1861 the colebrated "Connell" Stamp was issued and it was in use but one day when it was withdrawa from ubo bacause it had Mr. Connell's portrait on it.

In 1863 a two cent stamp was issued similar to the others.

## NEWFOUNDLAND.

Stamps were first issued in Newfoundland in 1857. There was nine values of various cclors and shapes The 1 pence and 5 pence were square, with a crown in the centre, with roses (two), shamrock and thistle at each corner ; on the left "St.John's," at top "Newfound," on right "land," at bottom "Postage" and ralue in words; also, value in each corner in tigures. The 2 pence, 6 pence, 6 pence half-penny, 8 pence and 1 shilling, all rectangular in shape, baving a bunch of roset, sham. rocks and thistle on a white ground in the centre. Above thig "St. Jobn's, Newfoundland," in a curved line ; "Postage" and value in words at botton ; ralue in figures in each corner. The 3 pence is triangular in shape, having a rose, sbamrock and thistle in centre, "St. John's. Newfoundland," along the upper sidea, and "Postage. Three Pence," across the bottom.

In 1866 stamps with values in cents were issued. They were of various designs. A codfiation the 2 cent; a seal on the 5 cent; Prince of Wales on the 10 cent ; head of Queen to left on the 12 cent; a sailing vessel on the 13 cent, and a full-faced portrait of Queen Victoria wearing a crown, on the 24 cent.

In 1868 a 1 cent lilac was ingued, having a portrait of the Prince of Wales, dressed as a Highland boy. In 1870 a 3 cent atamp was issued, having portrait of Queen to right. in widow's cap, also a 6 cest stamp of eimilar design.

In 1887 a set of stamps of new design were issued, having head of Newfoundland dog on the half cent, and a sailing versel on the 10 cent.

They were lozenge-shaped, with a crown in the centre, above the crown. a rose, at the botiom a may fower, at the right a thistle, and at the left a ahamrock. Along the two upper sides "Nova Scotia," along the two lower onea the value in words, and "Pottage," and in each corner the value in figures.

In 1853 the 1 penuy was issued. The design was head of Queen in a lozenge-shaped frame, "Nova" above, "Scotia" below. "Postage" on the right, the value in words on the left, and the value in figures in each corner. In 1860 five new stamps were isaued. The 1, 2 and 5 cent had the head of Queen to left in a circle, "Nova Scotia" above, value in words below. The other stamps of this issus were similar in design, with a full face portrait of the Queen.

## NOVA SCOTLA BILL BTAMPE.

Sometime after Confederation the goveroment ascertained that certain persons were buying large quantities of Bill Stamps in Novs Scotia, and sending them to the other provinces, there being a difference of about $2 \frac{1}{3}$ per cent $b$-tween the Canadian and Novia Ncotia currency. Thus, you see, they were defrauding the revenue. To prevent this an Order in Council was passed, ordering that all Bill Stamps for use in Nova Scotis should be surcharged with the letters "N. S." As the currency was вoon corrected these stamps were in use but a short time and so are quite rare, especislly the higher values.

The 1, 2 and 3 dollar are surcharged at the top, all the other valings are surcharged at the bottom

## ONTARIO.

The onily stampa issued exclusively for use in thig Province were Law Stamps The first of theae were isgued in 1864 They were large rectangular stamps, perforated, and designed as follown:-Full length figare of Justice, blindfolded, holding aloft with the right hand a pair of balances, and grapping with the left haud a sword, pointing downwards. The $5,10,20,30,40.50,60,70,80$ and 90 cent are green in color ; on the right "Canads" and on the left "Law Stamp"; at the top the value in a word in the centre, with the value in figures on both sides, and at bottom the value in words. The 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 dollars were green, with black cen'ra, havidg a figure of Justice similar to the lower values in the centre; on both sides the value in words; at the tup, in both corners, the value in figures, and between them "Canada"; st the bottom "Law Stamp." They were surcharged just above the figare in the centre, with the letters "C. F." deno ing Consolidated Fund; with "F. F.," denoting Fee Fund, and with "L. S.," denuting Law Society.

In 1870 a new get of Law Stamps were igstred for use in this Province. The design was similar to the previous isgue The figure of Justice wan not blind folded. The 5, 10. 20, 30, 40,50, 60, 70, 80 and 90 heve "Ontario Law Stamy," in two curved lines at the top; the value in figures in both lower corners, with the word "cents" between. The 1, 2. 3 and 4 dollars have the value in figures in both upper corner3., with the word
"Dollar" between; below this, in curved line, "Ontario"; across the bottom, "Law Stamp."

A great many of the last issue are found with the perforations cut nit, and many collectora have supposed that this sat was issued unper forated. Such, however, is not the case, the perforationg being cot off by certain vendors to mark them.

## PRINGE EDWARD ISLAND.

Stamps were first issued in this Province in 1860 There was three values : 2 pence. 3 pence, and 6 pence. The 2 pence has head of Queen to left in a circle; around this circle "Prince Edward Island Postage," acrose bottom value in words. The 3 pence was of similar design, hav. ing head of Quean in an oval frame The 6 pence has head of Queen in an octagon frame. The above stamps were perforated nine. In 1864 a 1 pence and 9 pence were added, design similar to the previons isaue.

In 1869 a 4 pence stamp was ıssued, design head of Queen to left ; "Prince Edward Island Postage" acposs the top in two curved lines; across the bottom "Four Pence." In 1870 a $4 \frac{1}{2}$ pence currency stamp was ibsued. Design, a full face view of Qaben in oval frame, surrounsed by the words "Prince Edward Island Postage; across the bottom "3d stg. Cy 4td."

In 1871 a new set was jssued with value in cents, They all had head of Queen to left, in various shaped frames. The 1 cent has Queen's head in circle, surrounded by "Prince Edward Island Postage"; value across the bottom in words and in each corner in figures. The 2 cent has head of Queen in an oval frame, "Prince Edward Island Postage" in a half circle at top, value across bottom in worda, and in each corner in figures. The 3 cont has head of Queen in an irregular circular frame, "Postage" across the top; below this, in curved line "Prince Edward Island"; scross the bottom the value in words, and in both upper corners the value in figures. Toe 4 cent and 6 cent have head of Queen in irregular fancy framea; "Postage, Prince Edward Island." acrobs the top in two straight lines; value in words across the buttom, and value in figures in each corner. The 12 cent has head of Queen in a circle ; "Prince Edward Island Postage" above in curved line; value in words across the bottom, and in figures in both upper corners.

## QUEBEC.

The first stamps issued for use in this Province was a get of Law Stamps in 1864. They were the hame design as those jssued for use in Upper Canada, and no doubt were printed from the same plate. They ware the same culor viz.: Green, and were surcharged "L. C." (Lower Canada) in red. In 1870 another set of Law Stamps was issued, the deaign being as follows:-Full length figure of Juatice in centre. The 10. $20,30,40$. 50, 60, 70, 80 and 90 cent have "Law Stamp,' across top in straight line, and below this the value in figures and the word "cents" acrose the bottom "Queber." The 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 dcllar, have "Law Stamp" in straight line across the top; below thin in curved line "\$1 Dollar 31;" on the left "Province" on the right of Quebee"; across the battom in a wavey line the value in worde.

## QUFBEO LAW REGIETRATION STAMPS.

The first issue of these stampa trok place in 1866. They were used on all documents filed in the Registry offices and also on search deeds. These stamps were square with the value in large white figures in the centre surrounded by a circle on which are the pords "Registration Lower Canada." In each upper corner there is a maple leaf and in each lower corner a beaver, and between the beavers the word "cents."

In 1871 a new set of these stamps was issued, the design being a beaver in a circle in the centre facing to the left.

Across the top in a straight line "Registration" below this in a curved line "Quebec," with the value in figures on both sides of it; acr ss the bottom the value in words:
