RULES.

I. Only ONE sheet of stamps, (notepaper folded 8. ins. by 5 ins.) to be sent from each Member for the Monthly Packet, which must have the full name and address ONLY of the Member plainly written on the back and must reach the Secretary by the 25th of each month

II. Yearly subscription 2s., one shilling to be devoted to a raffle at the end of the year, consisting of stamps among the Members, and the remaining shilling to pay for the return of Member's duplicates when the Packet has gone the round each month.

III. All stamps to be marked in plain figures and priced by S. Gibbons' latest catalogue. Also no common or much torn stamps to be sent for the Packets.

IV. The Packet must be forwarded on the following day to that on which it is received without fail, and a postcard sent to the Secretary saying it has been sent off.

V. Members writing to the Secretary and requiring an answer, are requested to enclose a stamped envelope, or a postcard.


