**STAMP MOUNTS.**

Stamp Mounts can now be obtained so cheaply that it is false economy to use any home-made article with the risk of spoiling one's stamps. Only the very best mounts, however, should be used, for many of the cheaper qualities are coated with impure gum that will probably discolour one's specimens.

**THE "ROYAL" STAMP MOUNTS.**

"ROYAL" stamp mounts are made of fairly thin, tough, semi-transparent paper, and are coated with pure gum arabic of such a consistency that the mounts will hold the stamps firmly in place as long as they may be peeled off without damaging either the stamps or the album.
