## INTRODUCTION.

THIS prospectus does not adequately represent my stock (which includes over 35,000 varieties), but is simply intended as a guide to that portion which appeals more particularly to the beginner and less advanced philatelists.

Collectors perusing this list will find many interesting and uncommon stamps offered at such moderate prices that they will be enabled to materially increase and enhance their collections with a very small outlay.

Special attention has been given in this list to the important matter of prices. I have given this my most careful consideration and have made reductions in every case where it was possible to do so. I can now confidently assert that my prices are absolutely the lowest at which it is possible to sell genuine and perfect stamps. It would be impossible to purchase equally good specimens elsewhere at such low prices.

In addition to large stock books of practically every country in the world, which I shall be pleased to show to any collectors calling at the Royal Arcade, I have prepared some hundreds of small books, each containing the stamps of a single country. These contain used and unused stamps and are all picked copies. They are particularly suitable for medium collectors and beginners, and prices will be found most moderate, ranging from 20 per cent.

Apart from these I am prepared to make up special selections to meet every customer's individual requirements, consisting of quite ordinary, medium, or very rare stamps. These are mounted in small books of about twenty pages, and may consist of used and unused in singles, pairs and blocks of four if desired. As each book is specially made up for each client it is respectfully requested that full instructions should be sent stating the name of the country required, whether used or unused or both are wanted, if rare, medium or only ordinary varieties are desired, and whether minor varieties are wanted.

In all cases, whether the collections consist of rare or only common varieties, I shall do my utmost to meet the requirements of each individual client. Customers with whom I have not previously done business should forward a suitable reference or cash deposit.



When starting a collection of stamps it is generally advisable to purchase one or other of the packets advertised in this list. The larger the number of varieties in the packet the better the value in proportion to the price paid. A packet I can confidently recommend to beginners, as being excellent value and forming a splendid foundation for a collection, is my special one of 2000 varieties, price 60s. Each stamp contained in this is a clean and perfect specimen, and if purchased separately the stamps would cost at least six times the amount charged for the packet.



Collectors should specially note that all my stamps, whether used or unused, are in perfect condition. Damaged stamps, except great rarities, have no value whatever, and though a novice might fancy that a poor copy of a stamp catalogued at say 5s. is cheap at 1s. it is not so in reality, but is dear at any price. Collectors should beware of rare stamps offered at ridiculously low prices, such stamps invariably turn out to be poor, dirty, miserable copies, or damaged specimens that have been more or less skilfully repaired and therefore practically valueless.
