In the present state of knowledge concerning revevne ktampa, it is simply impossible to make the book perfect, nor would it be advisable to do so, if the necessary dats were at hand, as the supply of these labels j日, at $p$ esent, very limited, which would in that case, nare it impossible to fill the album. Perhaps the greatest charn in collecting revenne stamps consista in the uncertainty and romance connceted with it, nearly every amateur having specimens in bis aloun which are totolly unknown to his brother eollectors; and there being to definte value or degree of value yet established; but, of course this state of things is rapidly passing away, aud ere many years, or even montlas lave elapsed, collcctors will awake to the knowledge that they have some priceless rarities among their reveune stamps which, perhapa, have only cost them the two or three cents.

Taking these fects into consideration, spaces have only been prepared for well known and obtainable нeries of foreign revenue stamps; but by the plentiful distribution of blank pages throughont the book, ample room has been tecured fur all tiscal stamps that may be acquired by the owner. In regard to the empsions of the United States the case is very differomt, as nearly every American Philatelist is debirous of obtaining a complete set of' the tiscal stamps of his own country. Therefore great care has been taken to provide space for every stamp that has ever been iseued by our own country, with the exception of beer, spirit, and tobaco stamps, which it hat beeu prouounced illegil to collect, but as labge numbers do collect them, sumfient blank pages have been left for their accommodation, and taking into consideration their lacge size, they cau be arranged with equal facility withont the aid of limes.
