TERMS.

A perusal of the following is requested, as non-attention to the various Rules may lead to disappointment, and the Conditions named must in all cases be conformed to.

1. The following list is intended as a guide to those correspondents who may have stamps in quantity which they desire to exchange for stamps, crests, or scraps named in our catalogue, or prospectus, or used stamps from our dealers' list.
2. Exchange orders should be of double the amount required, to allow for certain stamps which we can only supply for cash; correspondents will then receive what they desire. For parcels of common used stamps, used stamps of a similar quality should be ordered, as we do not undertake to send unused or rare in exchange for such; or if the selection is left to us, we will send good value in such stamps that recent advantageous purchases enable us to sell at a low price. We cannot undertake to send all unused for used.
3. Books, periodicals, catalogues, and some unused stamps, cards, &c., are not supplied in exchange, they are only procurable for cash.
4. In most cases the prices we allow are affixed: where they are not, it being impossible to enumerate all, the stamps should be sent on approval, and price named, as we make no offers beyond what are herein quoted. Any priced too high will be promptly returned.
5. The prices quoted herein are what we offer, not what we sell at. Our offers are for either used or unused, unless otherwise stated. For rarities the price depends greatly on their condition. Should the quotation given be deemed insufficient, it would be well in the case of rarities to send on approval, always naming the lowest that will be accepted. Where the kinds are not enumerated, it is on the understanding that the stamps are fairly assorted, and not the scarcer or better kinds picked out.
6. A detailed list should be sent with every consignment, priced by this circular, and enclosed in a separate envelope, if the stamps are sent by book or parcel post. The stamps must also be properly sorted in separate lots to render them easy of examination, as we cannot undertake to sort and value such. They must not be stuck on sheets. No single transaction must be less than 1s.
7. Imperfect or soiled specimens are useless. The prices named for envelope stamps is presuming they are not cut round. Cards must be entire; if cut, they are reckoned as current adhesives.
8. We cannot too strongly impress on our correspondents the necessity of securely wrapping parcels intended for us, and invariably sending name and address of sender plainly written with *each* packet. Stamps should never be sent in cardboard boxes, as they are sure to arrive smashed, and the contents more or less lost.
9. In all cases postage for reply must be sent, whether to defray postage of the stamps required in exchange, or to return those sent us, in case they do not meet with our approval. These amounts can be sent in unused low values current in the country from whence the order is sent. If this is omitted, the exchange is sent per book or letter post, double cost of postage against exchange being charged.
10. These exchange rates are not cash offers, and we reserve to ourselves the right of declining or rescinding any. Stamps bought for cash. Vendor must name price, and, if possible, send on approval. Exchange business by letter only; and we strongly recommend 2d. extra for registration, if the order is at all valuable.
11. We cannot undertake to supply stamps ordered or selected by the sender in exchange for the stamps marked with a *. Correspondents sending us these kinds should leave the selection to be sent in exchange entirely to us, and we will do our very best to give satisfaction.
12. Insufficiently prepaid letters and packets are invariably refused by us. Full address with *every* communication is particularly requested. Every possible precaution is taken, but we cannot be responsible for letters or parcels lost in transit.
