P R E F A C E .

There is probably no amusement of the present day more popular and instructive than that of collecting Foreign Postage Stamps, and in the hopes that we can add to the present number of collectors has induced us to write these few lines.

Postage Stamps were first issued in Great Britain in the year 1840, and from time to time have been adopted by other countries, our own Government first issuing them in 1847, and now there is scarcely a country in the world that has not acceded to this method of pre-paying postage, so that it must be at once apparent to every intelligent person, that there is a vast deal of information gained from the study of these labels, coming as they do from every part of the world, and bearing on their face, either the arms of the State or portrait of the ruler, and in nearly all cases the currency of the country where used, so that unconsciously the collector is made acquainted with the Geography, History and Currency of the various nations.

Were we to enumerate all the advantages to be gained from the study of Philately, we should far exceed the limits of the present work, so we must refer our readers for information to the *JOURNAL OF PHILATELY*.

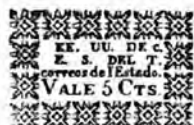

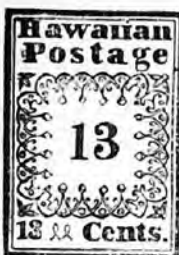
