PREFACE.

In presenting to our friends and the stamp collecting public in general the first edition of our price catalogue, the eighth publication of its kind issued in the United States, we make no special claim that the meritorious features it presents render it vastly superior to the publications of other dealers. Whatever we ourselves may think on the subject, we have both the good taste and the modesty to leave that matter to the verdict of our patrons, satisfied that our claims on their attention and consideration will not have been made in vain. In compiling this work we have endeavored as far as lay within our power, to produce a *price* catalogue in which the only attractive features would be the moderation of the scale of prices, and which would owe none of its merits to the dubious attractions of glittering show. How we have succeeded, the catalogue will best show for itself; those persons who want an ornamental creation will be disappointed, but the consciousness of the fact that on the vital point of moderate prices our catalogue will meet the approbation of many stamp collectors, will more than compensate us for the pain we experience in thinking that the well-meaning persons who love display should have been disappointed. The tendency of prices in stamps has for the last two years been in common with everything else, downward, and our catalogue has been compiled on that basis. We have not catalogued the varieties existing through shades of color, watermark, or perforations of stamps, as there are but few collectors of all these varieties. In order to make this work permanent, we shall issue from time to time supplementary leaves of newly issued stamps, which will be sent gratis to purchasers of this edition.

SPECIAL NOTICES.

All the prices in this list being the very lowest we can allow no discount on them except when six stamps or packet of one kind are ordered at one time, in which case seven will be sent for the price of six, or fifteen for the price of twelve. Our *net* prices taken as they are, will be found lower than those of other dealers even when 20 to 40 per cent. is deducted from their list prices. Dealers wishing to buy stamps in quantity are respectfully referred to our wholesale list.

We do not wish to say that we have in stock all the stamps priced in this list, as that is really impossible for any dealer, no matter how large his stock may be, but we can assure our patrons that all orders will be promptly executed, or, when some of the stamps ordered are not in stock, we will either return the money for same or keep the order on file and execute it at an early period; however, we have no hesitation in asserting that our stock of adhesive stamps, stamped envelopes, and post cards, is second to none in variety, and is constantly increasing.

Our large Foreign correspondence enables us to obtain all novelties *direct* as soon as issued, and which consequently we can sell very cheap.

In ordering from this list our patrons would oblige by attending to the following:

All orders should be plainly written; giving name of country, date, value, and price of each stamp. Senders name and address should accompany every communication.

Remittances must accompany all orders and should be sent by correspondents in the U. S. and Canada per P. O. Order, Bank Notes, or Bankers draft, payable in New York. Small amounts (under \$1.00) may be sent in unused 1, 2, or 3 c. postage stamps.

By correspondents in Great Britain and British Colonies per P. O. Order, Bank Notes, or Bankers drafts payable at New York. Small amounts may be sent in unused $\frac{1}{4}$ or 1d. current postage stamps. \$1 = 48.

Register all valuable letters.

The prices in this list are in *cents* in the first column for *unused*, in the second column for *used* stamps, warranted to be genuine and in perfect condition, envelope stamps either uncut or cut square. Post cards if *unused*, *uncut*.

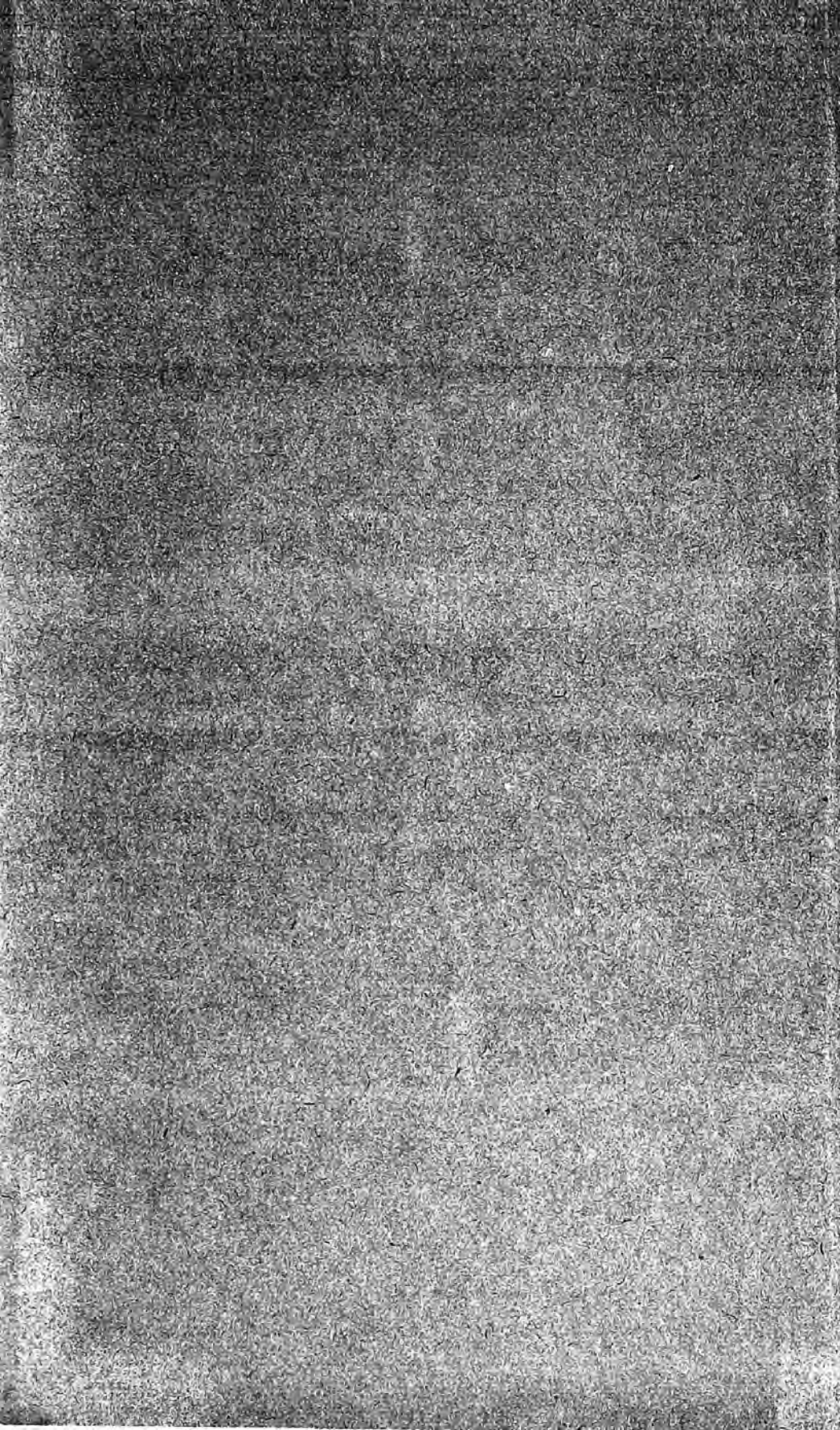

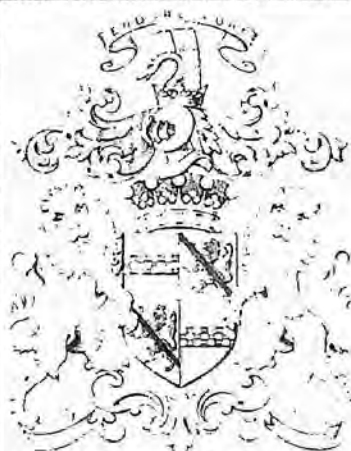
