By Correspondents in the British Colonies, should be made either by Money Order, Bill of Exchange on London, or, when the sum does not exceed 2/6, by Postage Stamps of *small* values.

By Correspondents in the United States, should be made either by Money Order, Bill of Exchange, or Dollar Notes, which last will be allowed for at the rate of 3/6 each. Sums under 2/6 may be sent in one-cent Postage Stamps at currency rates.

By Correspondents in France, may be made in Money Orders, Notes on the Bank of France, or by Bill of Exchange on London. Sums under 2/6 may be sent in Postage Stamps of *low* value.

By Correspondents in Belgium, Germany, Holland, and Switzerland, may be made either by Money Order, Prussian Treasury Notes, or, when the amount does not exceed 2/6, in Postage Stamps of the *lowest* values.
