IN the following catalogue it is attempted to show every separate issue, even when only distinguishable by perforation or watermark, but no list of varieties is attempted, and is perhaps not desirable in an ordinary sale catalogue. Except where an issue is known from the preceding one, by watermark or perforation, no notice is taken of these matters. Collectors requiring these particulars and list of varieties, are referred to the catalogue of Mr. Pember-ton's collection, which can still be supplied, price threepence. Collectors who ignore these points, are advised in all cases to purchase the cheapest sets, as, for instance, the current Ceylon, in preference to the imperforate star series. This class, and also those collectors who wish to have every distinct issue, will find this catalogue fully adequate for their purpose. Collectors of the French school, who go into the minutiae of stamps, can have selections sent on approval. All stamps, not otherwise described, are rectangular, printed in colour, on white paper. When printed black, on colour, the colour of the paper only is given; but, when printed in colour, on coloured paper, both colours are noted. The system of consecutive numbering being inconvenient for a catalogue altered monthly, it has not been adopted; customers will, therefore, take care to give sufficient particulars in ordering. It is well in all cases to send a good list of wants, with remittance, that, should any be out of stock, others may be substituted. Those who want such rare stamps, as are seldom to be met with, had better write before sending remittance.

Terms, cash, in advance. Remittances, under ten shillings, may be made in uncut stamps; over that sum, in post office order, from which the cost of order may be deducted.
