besides we give a valuable Premium stamp FREE with each remittance of \$1 00 or over at one time, usually consisting of one or more stamps, worth about ten per cent of amount remitted. We have over 10,000 names of persons who have received our sheets and have opened accounts with 3,000 to 5,000 agents almost all the year round; during the busy months the number sometimes reaches 6,000 to 7,000.

Rare Stamps, valued at from \$5 00 each and upward, will be sent to advance collectors upon receipt of good reference.

We do not allow 50 per cent discount on such very rare stamps, but still allow enough to make prices very reasonable.

Cheap Stamps for Beginners a Specialty.

We have every facility to supply the wants of the beginner, and our stock of cheap sheets is simply enormous.

Our prices compare favorably with those of other dealers, being in most cases lower, although our discounts are as large.

Orders for packets, sets, albums, etc., should not be written upon the blank formulas sent out with each lot of sheets, but must be written plainly on a separate piece of paper, with full name and address of sender. It is only by strict adherence to this rule that orders can be filled without delay.

Returns for Sheets must be made ten days after receipt. Collectors or agents who desire to retain them longer should inform us by postal card, explaining the delay.

Remittances should be made in unused U. S. Stamps of 1 or 2c (latter preferred) denominations for amounts under fifty cents, while larger amounts should be sent by Post Office Money Order, Express Money Order or Draft. Personal checks for small amounts are subject to 25c each for collection. Bank notes or silver may be sent safely by registered mail; the latter must be wrapped up well, otherwise it will wear through the envelope.

All valuable letters are sent by registered mail, and we request our agents to return them in the same way, otherwise we will not be responsible if lost.

If our patrons will observe the above rules, they will never find reason for complaint, as we give prompt and careful attention to every one, whether his returns are large or small.
