## PREFACE.

---

I have had under consideration for some time the advisability of compiling this catalogue, and, in order to be better equipped for the undertaking, I have been in correspondence with Australian dealers and collectors for more than a year, resulting in the acquisition of the stocks of two dealers, as well as additional supplies from other sources. With these additions to my stock, and with my own collection, practically complete, as a guide, I have been enabled to compile this catalogue.

While I do not claim absolute correctness in all details, I hope that this compilation may serve as a general guide to my fellow collectors both as to classification and present market values.

The prices quoted are for unused copies in the first column, and for used copies in the second.

The manner of the folding of double or reply cards is indicated as follows:

- T. 3. folded at top, reply printed on 3d page.
- T. 4. folded at top, reply printed on 4th page.
- B. 3. folded at bottom, reply printed on 3d page.
- B. 4. folded at bottom, reply printed on 4th page.
- R. 3. folded at right, reply printed on 3d page.
- R. 4. folded at right, reply printed on 4th page.
- L. 3. folded at left, reply printed on 3d page.
- L. 4. folded at left, reply printed on 4th page.

The perforations of letter cards are noted in accordance with the diagram below, the Roman figures "I, II., III., IV." indicating the style, and the letters "B" (bottom), "T" (top), the position.



Cards must never be *pasted* in a book, but mounted in "LOHMEYER'S POSTAL CARD ALBUMS," descriptive list of which will be mailed upon request.
