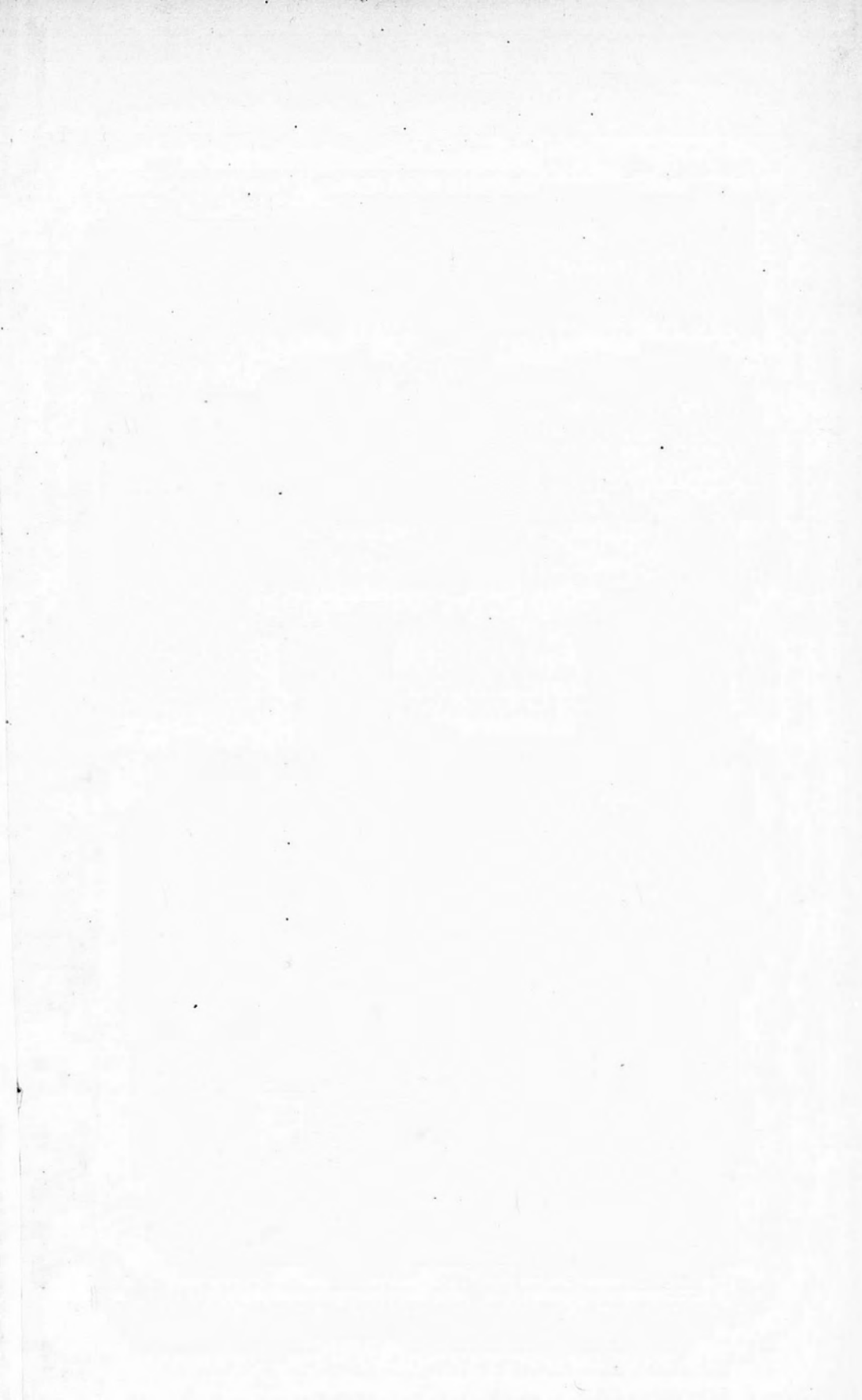

PREFACE.

When collecting stamps first began in 1857, and for many years afterwards, collectors had almost entirely to depend upon their friends, abroad or at home, to obtain stamps for their collections and exchange duplicates with fellow-collectors, as at that time no one had thought of making a business of dealing in stamps. To obtain an address of any one in Cape of Good Hope or Brazil was a privilege granted to very few in those days, but when at length someone started to sell stamps, collectors had not so much difficulty in obtaining specimens desired, although they often had to pay more for one stamp than they would probably have had to pay for a dozen if they had waited to hear from their friends. But like all MANIAS a great amount of exertion to excel in number and cleanliness of specimens would not let them wait for the next mail.

Twenty-nine years after (1886) a collector can buy for one dollar or less a larger amount of stamps than he could then for ten dollars, but of course not the same varieties.

But still the idea of having a correspondent in some far off country is often the first thought of most collectors, and to facilitate this end I present this Directory.

The names of collectors given in this book I guarantee to be BONA-FIDE, no fictitious names or addresses being inserted to fill up.

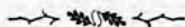
