It is recommended that collectors in the first place, confine themselves to the task of obtaining a specimen of each of the twenty-two hundred stamps issued, which being consummated, varieties of perforations, shade of color, or other anomaly may then be indulged in.

In the opinion of all sensible collectors, the fact of the sheets of stamps being divided by perforations does not in any mamer constitute a difierence from those not so divided.
