These prices are in United States money;—one dollar=four shillings=five francs. Remittances may be made by P. O. order, bank-draft on Kobe or Yokohama, Japan, or by U. S. currency in registered letter; small amounts in unused stamps of low denominations.

**TERMS.**—Cash must accompany all orders of \$5.00 or less. Larger lots will be sent by registered mail at buyer's risk to well-known and reputable dealers or to anyone sending a satisfactory written reference. For orders of 2.00 or less, postage is extra, 5 c. to the U. S. & Canada, 10 c. to other countries.

**EXCHANGE.**—There is no market for foreign stamps in Japan, but as I have a private collection of about 5000, I desire collectors who have good duplicates to send, on approval, stamps worth from 5 cts. to \$1.00 each. They must be priced at least  $\frac{1}{4}$  less than the prices of the SCOTT Co., or Stanley Gibbons catalogue, for my stamps are marked for cash and are very low. Any one desiring rare varieties will please send others equally good.

I send only stamps in perfect condition and accept only such stamps. No revenues, locals, nor reprints are desired, and no unused ones except those of low denominations. Exchange is exclusively at retail prices. I have also many good foreign stamps to exchange or sell.
