CONDITIONS.

Net cash should be paid in advance. Remittances must, in all cases, accompany order sufficient to cover return postage. The stamps are priced very low in our list, and we cannot allow any reduction. We do not attend to inquiries and offers unless they are accompanied by sufficient unused stamps for reply. If remittances be made by unused foreign stamps $2\frac{1}{2}$ per cent. extra must be remitted for exchange.

The prices quoted are strictly intended for cash purchasers. We shall, however, take in exchange for the Native States' stamps only the rare varieties which are mentioned on page 6 of the Exchange Circular; to secure a prompt reply full address with detailed communication must be given. We do not, under any circumstances, hold ourselves responsible for letters, books or parcels lost in transit.

Foreign correspondents are requested to notice that under the new regulation all stamps, post-cards, and envelopes either used or unused must be sent by letter post, except to countries where there is a parcel-post in operation.

Correspondents are requested to remit a sufficient sum to cover loss sustained by deficient postage, otherwise part of the money remitted in payment of the order must go to make up the deficiency.

This does not apply to Great Britain and those countries which are not included in the postal union.

Remittances from abroad should be made by Post Office Order or Bank-notes at the current rate of exchange. The following are the approximate values of foreign paper-money, but we do not bind ourselves to accept notes at these rates:—

RATE OF EXCHANGE.

1 Dollar = 4 shillings; 5 marks = 4s. 10d.; 1 Florin or Gulden = 1s. 7d.; 5 Krona = 5s. 3d.
1 Rouble = 1s. 8d.; 1 Lei = 8d.; 1 Peseta, lira or drachma = 9d.; 20 Francs = 15s. 9d.

We shall accept of Foreign unused postage stamps, except Railway, Local, Telegraph Stamps and Coupous. Persons desiring to buy stamps about the value of £20 will receive commission at the rate of 5 per cent. provided that the selection of the varieties is left to us.

TERMS OF EXCHANGE.

1. This exchange list is intended as a guide to our constituents, both Dealers and Collectors, who may have stamps in quantities which they desire to exchange for others quoted in our lists or select varieties from our approval sheets.

2. For rare stamps not mentioned in this list, vendors should name their lowest prices and send on approval, and we shall reply by return of post.

3. In all cases postage for reply must be sent in the form of unused stamps, whether to defray postage of the stamps required in exchange or to return those sent us in case they do not meet with our approval. If return postage is not sent double the value of postage will be charged against the exchange sent.

4. The prices herein are not cash offers, but we can, in most cases, buy for cash, but at a small discount. Persons wishing to sell for cash should name their lowest prices. Soiled or imperfect specimens are useless, and cannot be accepted at any price.

5. Exchange orders must always exceed the amount required by, at least, one-half to allow for any that may be out of stock at the time, or of which the supply is so limited, that we are obliged to reserve them for cash orders only. Correspondents will, under such cases, receive only such stamps as they require.

6. In all cases the stamps must be sent on approval, properly sorted in separate lots, to render them easy of examination, as we do not undertake to sort and value mixed consignments. They must in all cases be sent loose, and a detailed list of every consignment, priced according to this list, must be sent, and enclosed in a separate envelope if the stamps are sent by book, sample, or parcel post.

7. Correspondents abroad would much oblige us by prepaying their letters and packages sent to us with the rarest stamps especially *provisionals* current at the time of posting, and we shall reciprocate the favour.

8. Insufficiently prepaid letters and packets are invariably refused by us.

9. We undertake to sell very rare stamps on commission provided they are sent to us on approval sheets without the name of the Firm, and with prices clearly marked, and with particulars of rarities.
