INTRODUCTION.

H. R. VICTOR, in presenting the 6th Edition of his Stamp List, begs to return his sincere thanks to those Collectors who have given him so large a share of their patronage since he commenced business some years since. He believes that he has now been longer in the trade than any other stamp dealer, and this fact may serve as an indication of the large business he has always done. His constant desire is that he should furnish not only stamps in good order and at a reasonable price, but also that all of them should be *genuine*; and to this latter point he gives the most particular attention. In consequence of this, a *few* of his stamps may appear rather high-priced, but this is the case only with such as are now very rare, and of which there are many forgeries current. Collectors should exercise great caution in purchasing Swiss Cantonal, Romagna, old Italian, and many other stamps, since there are, at present, an immense quantity of high-priced and rare stamps forged at Hamburg and other places, and sold as genuine by unprincipled traders. However (to the best of H. R. Victor's belief), Collectors may always rely upon the stamps sold at his Establishment, since his fixed rule is *never* to sell as genuine a stamp known to be forged.

As will be seen on referring to the List, the prices of many varieties have been greatly reduced, while such stamps as are not included in it can be readily sent (at reasonable rates) on receiving a list of the stamps required. H. R. Victor willingly sends out the cheaper stamps on approval, on receipt of a small deposit, or a respectable reference. All stamps sold are in good order, and genuine. Rare stamps will be bought to any amount.

Terms :—CASH in all cases, as this is the fairest and safest way of doing business. Stamps taken in payment to any amount, but Post Office Orders (payable to H. R. Victor at Belfast Post Office), are preferred for sums over £1. The prices quoted admit of no abatement.

N.B.—The stamps in this catalogue are nearly all kept regularly in stock, but as some of them are only to be had in small quantities, collectors would do well to make an early application.
