There are also designated compartments for nearly fifty Post Cards, 10 gether with ample rootr for new. Local Stamps have no spaces prepared for then, but blank leaves are left, so that the collection ot them is optional. Revenue or laill Starips atre not included.

The pages are 360 in thumber, and are adomed with a very handsome series of Arms of Countries, expresslv piepared for this Album, and over 700 illustrations of rare stamps.

The Altum is printed in black, on a whise paper of extra quality, specially manufactured for it, and is elegantly bound in six different styles, the prices varying according to quality and paper. The cover is from a new design, and the size of the work is ro in. by 88 . in.
