The pages are 360 in number, and are adomed with a very handsome series of Arms of Countries, expressly prepared for this Album, and over 700

illustrations of rare stamps.

The Album is printed in black, on a white paper of extra quality, specially manufactured for it, and is elegantly bound in six different styles, the prices varying according to quality and paper. The cover is from a new design, and the size of the work is 10 in. by 8%, in.
