PREFACE.

Many people look upon the collecting of Postage Stamps as a trifling pursuit, suitable only for boys, to help them in learning Geography, and the names of the rulers or coats of arms of the different countries, or to furnish them amusement for a short time, but we think its merits are generally underrated.

Postage Stamps require the most skilful engravers, and by the talent displayed in their production, the relative progress of any country may be safely estimated. The arrangement of a collection needs great care, and by this means, as well as by comparing them with each other, the taste of the collector is greatly improved, and he is led on imperceptibly to a love of the fine arts.

Since our last edition many changes have occurred, new countries have adopted the system of prepayment, old issues have been superseded by new ones, and the English colonies seem gradually to be approaching a decimal currency. On the whole we think there has been considerable improvement, take for instance the new English sixpenny stamp, while some countries like Egypt, have gone backward.

We give now a list of 2,500 different stamps, not including the many varieties of shade, perforation, or watermark, nor the various Local Stamps and Post Cards, by keeping all of which a collection may be swelled to from five to ten thousand. We have made some changes in this edition which we hope will be regarded as improvements, one is the insertion of the date of each stamp, and the addition of a money table which we have taken from the catalogue of Alfred Smith & Co., of Eath, England, the values in the last column should be reckoned in gold; another the omission of Post Cards, which require to be kept separate from an album, also the omission of the Russian and other local stamps which afford great vexation and little satisfaction. Some have thought we should include the Hamburg locals and the Shanghai stamps, the former were only manufactured to swindle collectors, and of the latter we do not believe in the first emission, and the cents issue are at best merely local company stamps, and not a Government issue.

We are often asked if the stamp business is not dying out, but there were never more collectors than at the present day, the profits are much reduced by the great increase of dealers, but the prices of good specimens of old issues are continually rising. Twelve years ago at the New York Post Office the black 20c. French Republic, and the 90c. U. S. of 1821, were considered the rarest of stamps, and brought 25c. each, and no collection could hardly have been sold for \$25, now a single choice stamp will often bring that amount, and some of the best collections are valued at from £5000 to £3000. Some may suppose that these prices are entirely fictitious, but where one old collection is broken up, a dozen new ones are started.

The time for putting stamps into collections with a superficial observation has passed by, they have now become objects of study; the color of the stamp, its margin, condition, the quality and composition of the paper are all carefully examined, and every condition affects its value.

A minority of our best collectors prefer their stamps unused, of these the most particular preserve the original gum intact, and save the envelopes whole, but since so many reprints have been thrown upon the market, a majority prefer their stamps used, but desire them in perfect condition, with the margin or perforations entire, and the envelope stamps cut out square, and the local stamps on whole envelopes. Used stamps are more easily preserved, and the postmarks are often instead of a detriment, of great additional interest. Nearly all collectors make a distinction between perforated and unperforated stamps, many preserve all marked changes of color, and quite a number collect the different qualities of paper and watermarks.

We experience more than ever the difficulty of making Catalogues and Stamp Albums which shall contain all the new issues, they are hardly a month old before they are found to be lacking in many important stamps. We have introduced into this edition the dates of each stamp as a stepping stone to what we consider unavoidable, i.e., a complete change from the Alphabetical to the Chronological system. Catalogues, of course, can with trouble be continually changed, though by the latter course it would be only necessary to issue addendas, but there is no other plan by which a Stamp Album can be made permanent, than by completing it to a certain date, and after that keeping the new issues in a blank book until another volume should carry it to a later date. At the rate of additions and changes for the past three years, in five years from 1872 the stamps issued subsequently would require as large a volume as those issued prior to that time.

All stamps sold from this list are warranted genuine.

All orders should be plainly written out and footed up in separate columns for the used and unused, giving the date, color and value of each stamp, with the senders name and Post Office address each time.

Do not send money for those stamps priced in Italic figures, but send list of wants, and we will check off those in stock at the time. All letters of enquiry must contain stamp for reply.

In sending money through the mail always have the amount in as few pieces as possible, if change is required, do not send pennies, but unused stamps of low values.

All sums of three dollars and upwards, should be sent either by P. O. Order, or Banker's draft made payable to our order. We cannot become responsible for money sent otherwise. All letters containing over five dollars worth of stamps for sale or exchange should be sent registered or prepaid by express, we will do the same in return.

To those who are starting collections we would specially recommend our packets which have proved a decided success, over 300 of our packet "A" have been ordered during the past eight months. They are also more quickly forwarded as a general rule than other orders, for being made up previously they are all ready to send off, while in a press of business orders from Catalogue are sometimes delayed.

In reading this Catalogue, collectors will please observe the following:

INSTRUCTIONS.

The different nationalities are in alphabetical order; the Italic letters describe the stamps beneath; whenever they have watermarks they are also given with the abbreviation (wmk). The figure after the color at the commencement of the dotted line represents the number of marked differences of shade, and those stamps which come both perforated and unperforated have a colon (:) at the end of the dotted line.

The prices in the first column give the market value of unused, those in the last column of used stamps. Of those priced in Roman figures only we have enough to offer them for sale, of those priced in Italics we have a part, and we are continually obtaining others, which we will sell at these prices as far as we can supply them. When there are several varieties of color, perforation or watermark, our price is for the common one, for the others we charge an advance. For extra fine specimens of a rare stamp, or where they have been reprinted, for an original impression we often obtain more than our catalogue price.

We are continually purchasing large quantities of stamps, and hope that those who have any good stamps to sell, either in collections or otherwise will give us a chance to purchase; those we specially want are marked with a star, (*) for which we will pay in cash one half, and allow in exchange three fifths our list prices for limited quantities in good condition. We do not charge our list prices for any torn, clipped, greasy or badly defaced stamps; envelope stamps either used or unused are cut square, and our offer only extends to the same quality. We are also dealing largely in Revenue stamps of all kinds, both American and Foreign, and in original Locals of the U. S., including the Despatch stamps issued by private parties in the East, and the envelope stamps of the various Express companies of California and the Territories.
