## Preface

In 1899 the library of the American Philatelic Association, now the American Philatelic Society, was permanently deposited in the Carnegie Library of Pittsburgh, which agreed to care for all volumes received then or thereafter for the society and to make arrangements by which members of the society could obtain the books for use. The means for the growth of the collection were to be provided by the society.

The collection is classified and catalogued according to the scheme of classification in use in this Library and a full card catalogue has been made. The pamphlet catalogue is intended to make the collection more available to members of the society who live at a distance. It supersedes the catalogue of "Books on Philately in the Carnegie Library of Pittsburgh," published in 1901, which is out of print.

The Carnegie Library of Pittsburgh will be glad to receive any additions to the collection which may be made on behalf of the society, and especially any items which appear in the printed Want List.
